<b>Stolen Vehicle</b>	20-10782	Bressler Ln	Small red and white Honda CRS 50cc dirt bike stolen out of the garage sometime overnight. The vehicle does have an "AGV" sticker on the front underneath the handlebars which was applied by the owner. A similar vehicle was seen being driven in the area by a young black male with an "afro" style haircut. Contact was unable to be made with this subject.
<b>Disturbance – Domestic</b>	20-10745	Barrington Dr	female advised that her husband, who she is separated from, showed up at her home and was trying to get in. He was trying to get in to fight one of her friends in the house. He then started pushing the female before he left the area. S1 was located and arrested for Battery-Domestic.
<b>Criminal Mischief</b>	20-10740	Barrington Drive	V1 was visiting a friend that lives at the above listed address, when he came out to get something out of his, he discovered his front passenger window smashed out. The was a white landscaping brick on the floor board inside the vehicle. Its believed to be related to the disturbance that occurred at the same location (20-10745).
<b>Narcotics</b>	20-10802	SR100 and Seminole Woods Blvd	FCSO conducted a traffic stop on a W/M for committing multiple traffic violations. The male stated he did not have any ID and provided a name and date of birth that showed no record found. During a search of S1 two glass pipes uses to smoke narcotics were found. Residue inside the pipes tested positive for methamphetamine. S1 was placed under arrest for providing false information while detained and possession of drug paraphernalia.
<b>Narcotics</b>	20-10790	Blyth Ct	FCSO attempted to stop a vehicle for speeding on Oak Trails. The vehicle pulled on Blyth Place then to Blyth Ct and into the driveway of #7. The juvenile driver had thrown a Ziploc with about 112 grams of Cannabis (field tested) from his vehicle before pulling in the driveway. Juvenile male was arrested for Possession over 20 grams.
