Stolen Vehicle	19-11035	Princeton Ln	RP advising her son S1 is detoxing from sig31 use and asked her to borrow money. RP refused to give S1 any money so he took her laptop and told her he was going to pawn it. S1 then removed all phones from the house including RP cell phone, so she could not call 911 for help. S1 took the laptop and all the phones and stole RP's car. RP wishes to pursue charges on S1 and report her vehicle stolen. RP gave written statement. Vehicle entered into FCIC/ NCIC as stolen by dispatch.
Missing Person Juvenile	19-11052	Plainview Drive	RP advising her 15 yoa daughter M1 is missing. RP went into daughter's room this morning at 0600 to wake her up, and she was not there. BOLO sent to dispatch and aired. Juvenile entered into FCIC/NCIC as missing by dispatch.
Battery DV	19-11093	Madison Green Circle	RP, stating that her and S1 have been arguing all day about him cheating on her. It then escalated to a physical altercation and S1 took and smashed her phone in a rage. S1 was found to be the aggressor and was taken into custody and charged with battery DV.
Disturbance Physical	19-11139	Oleander Ave. Bunnell	S1 called in reference to a verbal disturbance between family members in the house. Investigation found that S1 slapped her adult niece (who lives at the residence with S1) when the verbal altercation escalated. Parties were separated and everyone had calmed down. S1 niece did not wish to pursue criminal charges. In lieu of an arrest, charges were forwarded to the SAO for simple battery-domestic violence against S1.
