| Death | 19-24316 | Marquette Av | 63-year-old male, was located deceased after neighbors were concerned because they haven't seen him in a while. Call active. |
| Disturbance Domestic | 19-24306 | Blaketon Court | S1 was in a verbal argument with his parents, over him being loud with his friends. During the argument, Adrian punched V1 in the face and hit V2 in the arm. Both subjects had marks on them and S1 was arrested for two counts of DV battery. |
| Violation of No Contact order | 19-24337 | Palm Coast Pkwy SW (Wendy's Homeless Camp) | A no contact order was located, naming O1 as the respondent and O2 as the protected party, but the charge was not Domestic in nature. Parties were separated, and a charging affidavit was completed on O1. |
| Warrant Service | 19-24318 | Library Homeless Camp | Information received that S1 was living in the camp at this location and had a warrant for her arrest out of Virginia reference Violation of release conditions. S1 was located and arrested after confirmation of the warrant, and transported to FCIF without incident. |
| Larceny-Shoplifting | 19-24338 | Palm Coast Pkwy SW | Loss prevention stated an unknown male entered the store and selected a bottle of cologne (\$60.00 value) and placed the cologne into the front pocket of his sweatshirt. The male then exited the store, passing all points of sale without attempting to pay for the item. Loss prevention confronted the male outside of the store and he fled on foot. The suspect was unable to be located. |
