Burglary Vehicle	26046-19	Peyton Place	Unlocked vehicle entered and social security card, NY driver's license, \$380 cash, and a checkbook was removed from the vehicle.
Burglary Vehicle (attempt)	26046-19	Parkview Drive	Suspect attempted entry into 2 vehicles at 3:45am but they were locked.
Narcotics	26039-19	Old Kings Rd (CVS)	CVS called in a suspicious truck with a U-Haul trailer in the parking lot. Upon S1 opening the trailer door, he quickly picked up a baggie and attempted to conceal it. The baggie contained 6 grams of heroin. Multiple used syringes were also located in the trailer. A bag belonging to S2 was also located which contained a controlled substance. S1 arrested for trafficking in heroin. S2 arrested for possession of a controlled substance.

The next morning O2 claimed that O1 came into the room, jumped on top of him and yelled obscenities at him. Due to lack of evidence and conflicting stories a primary aggressor was undetermined therefore no charges were filed.
