| 18-25587 | Death | Masters Ct | 69 Year woman who was under Hospice care, died in her home. Nothing suspicious was noted. |
| 18-25600 | Shoplifting, Fraud, Possession of Meth, Marijuana, paraphernalia | Cypress Point Pkwy | S1 and S2 were arrested after making a fraudulent return and taking merchandise from the store without paying for them. S1 also had marijuana, meth and paraphernalia in her purse. |

| 18-25669 | Assist Other Agency | Interstate 95 Milemarker 279 | VCSO called in reference to a fleeing vehicle. VCSO was not actively pursuing the vehicle. Due to not knowing exactly where the suspect vehicle and VCSO units were, Fireflight was launched to assist. FCSO units responded to Interstate 95, but DID NOT engage nor initiate a pursuit of the suspect vehicle. Deputy West observed the suspect vehicle traveling in a reckless manner north on Interstate 95. The suspect vehicle then exited the Interstate at the 289 Exit. The suspect vehicle lost control and crashed into the electronic crosswalk sign located on Palm Coast Parkway. S1 then exited his vehicle, and fled. S1 was later apprehended by FCSO. After complaining his head hurt, S1 was transported to Florida Hospital Flagler, treated and released. FCSO charges related to this incident include two counts of Resisting Without Violence, one count of Leaving the Scene of a Traffic Crash with Property Damage (approximately \$5,000usd), and Reckless Driving. S1 also faces a VCSO charges and additional charges from the Ormond Beach Police Department. |
