<b>Burglary (Residential)</b>	20-34654	Likins Ave	Unoccupied residence was unlawfully entered and vandalized with spray painting, windows broken and other damage. Nothing was missing, however the residence was completely ransacked. This incident occurred sometime over the past month. Report by Deputy Cuthbert
<b>Missing Juvenile</b>	20-34659	Renshaw Dr	16 year old male left voluntarily. Believed to be heading toward a friend's house in the Jacksonville area. Approximate delay in reporting of 1 hour. No access to a vehicle, no cell phone. Units BOLO'd US1 and I95 extensively but were unable to locate. M1 entered FCIC/ NCIC. Last seen wearing white shirt, black pants with a white stripe, and a black backpack. Deputy Pierre.
<b>Baker Act</b>	20-34633	Canal Ave	Residents at this location reported seeing a male in a tree on their approximately 20-30 feet off the ground who was acting unusual. Upon units arriving on scene it was apparent that the subject was under the influence of narcotics and was not responding to deputies. The Flagler County Sheriff's Office Crisis Negotiations Team (CNT) responded on scene as well as the Flagler County Fire Department and the Flagler Beach Fire Department. The Flagler Beach Fire Department utilized their ladder firetruck as CNT was in contact with the male, ultimately making a safe rescue without further incident or injury.
