Stolen tag	19-36974	Enterprise Drive	Registration plate had been stolen from motor vehicle. The tag was entered into NCIC/FCIC as stolen.
Domestic Disturbance	19-36930	Reine Place	Verbal argument.
Overdose	19-36980	Fernwood Lane	O1 was found by his mother injecting narcotics in the bathroom and unresponsive. He was blue in the face, not breathing and had no pulse when deputies arrived. Narcan was administered and CPR started. O1 regained consciousness and was transported to FHF by Rescue 22.
Missing Juvenile	19-37015	Bayside Drive	Mother reported her juvenile son as missing. He frequently runs away and comes home. BOLO issued and M1 was entered as missing into FCIC/NCIC.
Stolen Vehicle	19-36935	Cinnamon Street	A witness observed S1 pushing their neighbor's kids dirt bike across Mahogany Boulevard and began following him and called 911. S1 began fleeing from the witness on the dirt bike. The dirt bike tracks were followed by Deputy Gomez, Deputy Prevatt and Deputy McCarthy and the dirt bike was located hidden in the woods behind 5857 Mango Avenue. S1 was located coming from behind the residence and secured. After a positive show up identification S1 was arrested for burglary of an occupied dwelling (curtilage), grand theft of an automobile, possession of methamphetamines, possession of drug paraphernalia and driving while license suspended habitual.
