He then struck her and forced her to the ground. V2 walked in during the disturbance and tried to stop him. He then struck her as well. They were able to separate themselves and exit the residence to make contact with law enforcement. S1 was placed under arrest for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and 2 counts of domestic battery. Baker Act paperwork was also completed and left at the jail.
