<b>(Follow Up) Missing Juvenile</b>	19-38992	Island Estates Parkway	M1 returned home on 4/26/19. M1 has been removed from FCIC/NCIC.
<b>Disturbance Domestic</b>	39420-19	Freeland Lane	S1 was arrested for domestic battery after he punched and kicked his wife, and hit his adult children who came to their mother's aid during an argument. M1 was transported to the FCIF without incident. A Baker Act form was completed and left with the jail.
<b>Death</b>	19-39375	Century Lane	Female called in for a welfare check on her parents due to not being able to contact them. Upon arrival a female could be observed in the bed but was unresponsive. The daughter arrived on scene and was notified of the findings. ISD, CSI, and VOCA responded. Doctor signed the death certificate for the father.
<b>Larceny Shoplifter</b>	19-39419	E State Road 100 (Target)	S1 arrested for grand theft over \$300 for taking over \$1000 worth of video games. Another unidentified female used a key to open the display cases and stashed the video games for S1 to take. These subjects have targeted multiple different Target stores in Northeast Florida over the past month.
<b>Burglary Residential</b>	19-39390	CORD 305	V1 reported the pad lock on their gate was cut and the gate was found open. Taken from the property were two game cameras and a push mower. At this time it is unknown if entry was made into the residence.
