Baker Act	19-43713	Palm Harbor Pkwy	Adult female taken into custody under a Baker Act.
Overdose/Poisoning/Baker Act	19-43765	Wedgewood Ln	Deputies responded to a possible overdose at the location. Upon arrival deputies found female unresponsive, lips turning blue. Deputies learned the female uses fentanyl and heroin; Narcan was administered. The female did not respond to the first dose of Narcan; so a second dose was administered. FD/Paramedics arrived on scene; immediately started life saving measures. The female eventually regain consciousness admitted she took too much fentanyl intentionally; the female was transported to Advent Health. A Baker Act was left with the hospital.
Domestic Disturbance	19-43807	Cedarwood CT	S1 got into a verbal Domestic argument with her in-laws over her drinking. During the argument, S1 pushed her mother-in-law several times, ultimately pushing her mother-in-law on to the floor causing a large bump to the back of her head. S1 then went outside where she pushed her father-in-law. S1 was arrested for domestic battery and transported to the inmate facility without incident.
