Traffic Stop	20-55995	US1 and Royal Palms Drive	Dep. Schmidt attempted a traffic stop on a 2011 Nissan Maxima that fled North on US1 before turning on Whiteview Drive. Deputies observed the vehicle driving in a reckless manner north on Pine Lakes Parkway, losing visual in the area of Belle Terre and Bird of Paradise. Fire flight launched. While searching the area around 12 Buttermilk Drive, which was the registered owner's address, a neighbor reported seeing the vehicle parked behind the residence. The vehicle was unoccupied and confirmed as the one that fled earlier. Contact was made with S1 who answered the front door. She was uncooperative and refused to allow us to search residence or answer questions on who had her vehicle. Report by Dep. Schmidt.
