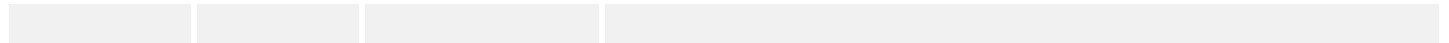

<b>Burglary- Conveyance</b>	19-63447	Riverwalk Dr	RP advised an unknown person(s) unlawfully entered his Boat that was parked in front of his residence between 7P and 8A and stole eight (8) fishing poles worth approximately \$5,000.00. See report by Deputy Colson for further.
<b>Disturbance w/ weapons</b>	19-63500	Rolls Royce Ct. S.	RP called to advise there was a physical disturbance involving multiple subjects. Deputies located blood on the front porch and rear screen enclosed porch and were able to make contact with homeowner inside of the residence. It was confirmed there were no other occupants inside of the home. Homeowner advised he did not know who was injured or whose blood was located at his residence and all subjects left. Male later located bleeding from the head and was transported to Halifax. Report by D/S Conway.

M1 stated he stayed with a friend last night because he knew he was in trouble for being out past his curfew. M1 was removed from NCIC/FCIC as missing. See report by Deputy Wallis.
<b>Physical Disturbance</b>	19-63515	6020 E SR 100 (Mobil)	RP advised they witnessed a male "beating" a woman in the driver's seat of an unknown make or model black passenger car. RP stated another male exited the rear seat of the vehicle and the suspect entered the passenger side of the vehicle and the vehicle fled west bound on E SR 100 at a high rate of speed. Units attempted to locate the vehicle but had limited information and were UTL. Contact made with the male that exited the vehicle who advised his cousin and girlfriend were involved in a physical disturbance and he attempted to break them up.
