<b>Burglary-Vehicle</b>	18-91396	Burning Bush Dr	S1 advised that an unknown person(s) unlawfully entered her unlocked 2011 Jeep bearing Florida tag GPZK08 and stole the spare key to the vehicle valued at approximately \$300.00. S1 did not wish to have the vehicle processed for DNA or latent prints. Neighborhood canvas conducted and cameras were located at 20 Burning Bush Drive; owner will review and advise if the footage captures anything. Key was recovered and turned over to owner, from case 18-91408.

The stolen vehicle had a stolen computer in it from 18-91442 which was collected. DNA swabs taken from steering wheel. Vehicle turned over to RO. Suspects from 18-91408 were arrested in regards to this case.
