
Dear Chief Doughney:

It has come to our attention that rocks and revetment are being removed from the rehabilitated rock structures which support State Road A1A in the City of Flagler Beach. The rocks and revetment are property of the Florida Department of Transportation, support the roadway and removal of such could cause a potential threat to public safety or welfare. Further, the Department has not given consent to the removal. This letter is to notify you that Flagler Beach Police Department law enforcement officers are hereby granted written authority pursuant to Section 810.09, Florida Statutes, to communicate an order to leave the following described property on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation in the case of a threat to public safety or welfare concerning the above subject:

Any and all portions of State Road A1A, and its supporting structures, within the jurisdiction of the Flagler Beach Police Department

We also request that the Flagler Beach Police Department officers take appropriate action to protect the Department's and State's property which is being removed. Please be advised that you are not authorized to engage in any activity which would constitute a violation of anyone's civil rights and are to follow existing legal guidance as to the methods used.
