THE SCHOOL GUARDIAN PROGRAM

SB 7026 Requires Safe-School Officers at Each Campus



- **Keep current SRD contract in place with FCSO**
- **4- High Schools**
- **2- Middle Schools**
- **5-Elementary**
- **1 Commander**
- **1 Sergeant**
- **(Total 13)**



- **Considerations to implement the School Guardian Program for all schools**
- **3 models**
- **Training current faculty/staff**
- **Creating a new Guardian Program**
- **Contracting armed security services that meet eligibility**



- **Future MOU with I Love You Guys on Standard Response Protocol and training for staff and students**
- **Table top reunification**
- **Continue Comprehensive School Threat Assessment (CSTAG) training.**
- **Continue working with Student Services and YMHFA.**

SAFE -SCHOOL OFFICER OPTIONS



- **School Resource Officers/Deputies** - Certified law enforcement officers who are employed by a law enforcement agency.
- **Guardians** - A school district or charter school employee or personnel, including teachers, who volunteers to serve as a school Guardian in addition to his or her official job duties. An employee of a school district or a charter school who is hired for the specific purpose of serving as a school Guardian. No authority to make arrests.
- **Contracted Private Security Guards**- Contracted private security agency who holds a Class “D” and Class “G” licence, provided the security guard has completed the Coach Aaron Feis training program



SCHOOL GUARDIANS

OPTION A

- Plain clothed concealed carry.
- Existing employee would will be trained
- MOU signed by The School Board to pay non-12 month employees for training.
- Will have to set procedures to identify these personnel in an active situation.
- Who could volunteer? Local Recommendations
 - Principals, Assistant Principals, Deans, Guidance Counselors, Media specialists, and Instructional and Non-Instructional employees that are not assigned to individual classes.
- Possible classroom teacher exceptions
 - JROTC, current service members, current or former law enforcement.



SCHOOL GUARDIANS

OPTION B

- **Uniformed employees for Flagler Schools.**
- **Eight School Guardians 188 (hourly)**
- **One Lead Guardian 261 (hourly)**
- **One Guardian Coordinator (salary)**
- **Lead Guardian and Coordinator will be used as floating positions, and substitutes as needed.**
- **Lead Guardian and Coordinator could also be used for Summer School additional resources.**
- **Extra curricular activities, would be additional cost.**





DISTRICT SRD REQUIREMENTS

OPTION C

- **Contracted Private Security Guards**
- **Flagler School currently has approved vendors**
- **No services have been put out for bid only inquires**
- **Possibility of no training required, as security personnel has already received the approved 144 hours of training**
- **Higher initial cost**

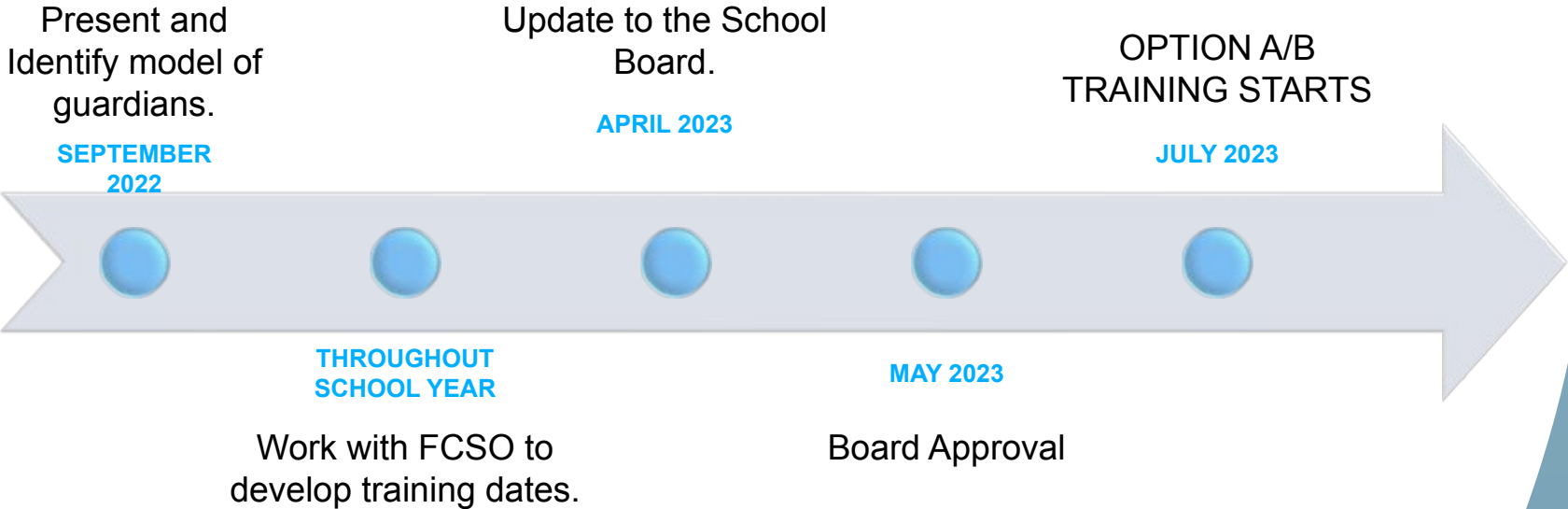


Insurance Information
