- (b) This subsection does not limit the ability of:
- 1. A private individual to express private speech or viewpoints or exercise rights protected by the First Amendment to the United States Constitution.
- 2. A governmental entity to display or erect a flag required or authorized by general law.
- (3) A governmental entity that displays the United States
 flag must display the United States flag in a prominent position
 that is superior to any other flag that is also displayed.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
