A vehicle with four subjects was stopped entering into the perimeter and three of the subjects had missing shoes, wet socks and grass on their clothing consistent with running through the woods. A perimeter was set and K9 tracked to behind a residence on Crystal Bay Court where two more subjects were located hiding in a canopy inside of a boat.
