Larceny	19-1008	N. Starling Drive	V1 stated he had been home all day, and his safe containing two firearms had been stolen. During the evening of 1/2/19, V1 opened his small safe located in the top drawer of his night stand to insert an extra pistol magazine. V1 then closed the drawer and went to sleep. At approximately 1038hrs on 1/3/19, two contractors visited the residence to perform warranty work and he believes they stole his firearms. A -Glock 19 Gen 4 9mm and a Springfield XD-9 9mm were entered stolen.
Domestic Disturbance	19-921	Buffalo Meadow Lane	S1 was placed under arrest after shoving and punching his mother, V1. His brother, O1 intervened to protect his mother and a physical altercation ensued between siblings. S1 was charged with two counts of domestic battery.
Domestic Disturbance	19-960	Flint Hill Lane	S1 and S2 were involved in a physical altercation. Each provided conflicting statements, and a witness could not identify a primary aggressor. Charges were submitted to the SAO on both subjects for domestic battery, parties separated.
