Missing person (juvenile)	19-91655	3535 Pirate Nation Way (Matanzas High School)	RP reported his 14-year-old son missing after coming to pick him up at Matanzas High School. RP stated that M1 was at Matanzas High School all day and was supposed to be picked up after detention. M1 got into an argument with his parents last night due to getting in trouble at school. M1 was entered into FCIC/NCIC as missing. See report by Deputy Held
Follow-up	19-91655	James Holland Park	Dep. Held observed M1 in the park and he was detained without incident. Contact was made with RP (father), who responded and took custody of his child. M1 was removed from FCIC/NCIC as missing.
Suicide Threat	19-91717	Beechwood Lane	RP requested a welfare check on her friend, who sent her a concerning facebook message. Deputies responded to residence but O1 was not home.
Follow-up – Baker Act	19-91717	Palm Coast Parkway SW	Deputies located O1 sitting inside his vehicle in the parking lot of the Circle K. O1 was placed under a Baker Act without incident.
Domestic Disturbance	19-91748	Renshaw Drive	Neighbors reported hearing a disturbance in the area. Deputies checked the area and heard a verbal disturbance at above address. While approaching front door, they heard a male yelling for someone to get off him. Contact was made with V1, who stated that his girlfriend pushed him and he had to restrain her. S1 was placed under arrest for DV battery after it was determined she was the primary aggressor. No injuries observed. Report made by Dep. Schmidt
