Shoplifter	<b>19-97629</b>	Palm Coast Pkwy SW (Walgreens)	Unknown black male entered the store and attempted to return an item. When the clerk would not allow him to conduct the return, he became angry and took a handful of cell phone "pocket sockets" from a display near the register. These items are valued at \$9.99 each but it is unknown how many he took. Male then left in an unknown vehicle.
DUI	<b>19-97536</b>	Plaza Drive Suite 106 (Houligan's Palm Coast)	Corporal Gamarra was flagged down in reference to a suspected drunk driver and possible domestic disturbance. Upon approaching the vehicle, the driver, S1 was clearly intoxicated. Deputy Capela conducted Field Sobriety Exercises and determined probable cause existed for arrest. The suspect resisted arrested and was subsequently arrested for DUI, Resisting Arrest with Violence, and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer.
