Disturbance Domestic	99247-18	Raemoor Drive	S1 was involved in a verbal dispute with the mother of his child over a phone issue. During the dispute S1 struck her several times and was arrested for domestic battery.
Disturbance Domestic	99298-18	Wedgewood Lane	S1 was under arrest for domestic battery after striking his girlfriend during an altercation, threatening her, and not allowing her to leave her room.
Missing Adult – Endangered	99274-18	Fellowship Drive	M1 was last seen on 10-18 by her boyfriend, O1. When he returned to his residence from a hospital stay he discovered that she was no longer at the residence and her vehicle (2016 gray Nissan Rogue bearing Florida tag ILYH72) was missing. Contact was made with M1' son who advised Florida Hospital Ormond called him advising that she had checked herself in but was discharged on the morning of 10-19. FCSO had conducted a traffic stop on her for driving without lights at 9:23pm on 10-19. Axon video shows she had a Hospital bracelet on and she advised she had left Ormond Hospital but was going to FHF due to her shoulder hurting. Lourdes never checked into FHF, her phone has been turned off and unable to ping, all businesses and hotels were checked with negative results, ISD notified, local and surrounding county BOLO issued, and she was entered into FCIC/NCIC as missing and endangered.
Baker Act	99288-18	Prospect Lane	Juvenile placed under a Baker Act and transported to Halifax Hospital.
Disturbance Weapons	18-99248	Sawgrass Road (County Ballfields)/	V1 was coaching softball when S1 went after him with a baseball bat making threats to hit him. S1 was placed under arrest for aggravated assault.
Disturbance Domestic	18-99627	Tangerine Ave/	O1 and O2 were in a verbal argument over a cable box. O2 stated that during the argument O1 pushed him to the ground. O1 denied pushing John and stated the incident was captured on their Ring Security Camera. The video footage showed that O2 threw himself into the door and then onto the floor and O1 never pushed him. Both subject refused to leave the residence and stated they were not in fear of each other.
