The driver, S1, was stopped and given field sobriety exercises. The male was ultimately arrested for DUI and cocaine possession transported to the FCIF without further incident. | Traffic Stop | 19-92750 | Old Kings Rd and Farmsworth Dr | Traffic stop initiated on vehicle travelling over the posted speed limit. Driver immediately attempted to exit vehicle and was detained. Driver, S1, was arrested and charged with DWLS with knowledge. His DL has been revoked for over two years. He was transported to the FCIF without incident. Report made Deputy Parker |
| Traffic Stop | 19-92661 | Lancewood Street | Deputy Chewning conducted a traffic stop for failure to come to a complete stop. Upon contact with the driver, O1, and front seat passenger S1. O1 advised she knew the registration was expired. Deputy Chewning asked S1 his name and he initially gave a false name then confirmed he was S1 and that he knew he had an active Flagler County warrant. S1 was subsequently secured for the warrant, during an inventory of the vehicle several forged checks were located in a back pack as well as drug paraphernalia.
