Burglary Residential – Battery	19-117857	Richmond Drive	Units originally responded to the residence with reports that an armed home invasion was occurring due to a narcotics related dispute. Upon arrival it was determined that a black male named “Dee” and his girlfriend arrived at the residence due to Dee believing that the victim stole pills from his residence in Daytona when he was there earlier in the day. The two argued in the front yard but Dee then forced his way inside the residence and pushed the victim’s mother once inside the house. Dee and the female then went into the garage and went inside a vehicle appearing to be looking for the pills. Once they were aware 911 was called, they left the house and entered a silver Nissan Maxima believed to be a rental vehicle and left the area. Investigative techniques yielded possible suspects. Sgt. Barile created photo lineups for both subjects and they were both positively identified. Charges for burglary of an occupied dwelling with battery were signed on S1 and charges for burglary of an occupied dwelling were signed on S2. Unable to locate the suspects throughout the night. Charges passed on to ISD who were notified of the incident. Report made by Deputy Pierre.
