<b>Stolen Vehicle</b>	20-10950	Ranwood Ln	Victim's sister took her vehicle from her driveway without permission and has failed to return the vehicle after being asked repeatedly.
<b>Disturbance - Domestic</b>	20-10971	Farmsworth Dr	S1 and V1 involved in an altercation in the driveway at V1 house. The couple have a child in common and V1 is pregnant with another child of his. During the altercation, S1 pushed V1 several times, causing her to fall to the ground, and "body slammed" her on the round. S1 also pushed her friend and witness, V2, to the ground. V1 was checked by a rescue unit on scene. No known injury to the baby at this time. V1 was uncooperative with the investigation, but was provided with domestic violence resource information. Aggravated battery charges completed on S1. Charges passed on to dayshift to attempt to locate.
