V1 then went out onto the patio to smoke a cigarette and S1 urinated in the pool. V1 stated she was angry and attempted to push S1 into the pool but S1 grabbed V1 from behind in a bear hug. V1 stated that during this incident S1 grabbed the back of her pants and pulled them down. S1 did not attempt to touch any of her genitals, breast or buttock during the struggle. After V1 said she was calling the police S1 fled on foot through the back yard.
