Burglary Vehicle	Birchwood Dr	V1 advised her vehicle was parked at this location between 1500 hours on 03/22 and 0900 on 03/23 while she was working at the location. Contact was made at the house and both male and female stated there was nothing physical. They were arguing and both had a hold of the phone. They were each trying to take possession of the phone. Domestic Disturbance	Bradmore Ln	S1 was involved in a disturbance with her live in boyfriend of appx 1-1/2 years. The 2 were involved in a disturbance which turned physical when S1 kicked her boyfriend in the right side of his face and punched him in the right bottom lip. He sustained bruising to the right side of his face and a swollen and bloody lip, consistent with his account of the incident.
