Overdose	19-22474	Lema Ln.	27 YOA female found unresponsive and not breathing. Upon arrival of Deputies, D/S Oldham administered Narcan and the female regained consciousness and a pulse. Female was transported to FHF by FCFD and admitted to using Heroin intravenously.
Drunk Driver	19-22460	US HWY 1 @ Old Dixie	FCSO conducted a traffic stop on a 2014 Kia bearing Florida tag 6230JU for driving 97 in a posted 55 MPH. The operator and sole occupant S1 conducted FSE's and was subsequently arrested and transported to the FCIF where he provided a breath sample of .229 and .237 respectively.
Domestic Disturbance	19-22470	Avocado Blvd	O1 stated that O2 grabbed her arm and pushed her when they arrived at the house. O2 advised that there was a verbal argument but that he did not touch O1. O1 had no visible injuries consistent with her account of events. O1 advised she wished to move out and left the residence. No charges were filed due to inconsistent accounts, lack of injuries, and lack of cooperation from all involved.
