RP left his residence this afternoon to take his family to dinner and when he returned, noticed some of his belongings were moved around. He then noticed a small amount of medical marijuana and his pistol missing. The firearm was entered into FCIC/NCIC as stolen.
Burglary Commercial	19-37156	Old Kings Road N (Bowling Alley)	At 0403 hours, Deputies responded to an alarm call at the bowling alley. Upon arrival, they located an unsecured front door that was visibly damaged. The building was cleared with nobody located inside. Contact was made with O1 (emergency contact) who arrived on scene. O1 confirmed that a cash register was missing but contained no currency. Surveillance video showed a male subject pushing a hand truck approach the front of the business at 0354 hours. He then pulled on the front door handle and was able to open the door. The suspect then entered the lobby area and attempted to remove an ATM machine but was unsuccessful. The male then grabbed a cash register and left. The suspect was wearing gloves and clothing to cover his identity. A copy of the surveillance video was obtained and placed into evidence.
