18-37228	Traffic Stop	Palmer Lane	Deputies approached referencing a reckless vehicle that constantly speeding on Palmer Lane. A traffic stop was conducted on a white dodge charger for standing on the right of way. S1 was arrested and charged with DWLS w/knowledge (felony), possession of marijuana U/20 and possession of drug paraphernalia.
18-37293	Criminal Mischief	Cypress Point Pkwy (Walmart)	V1 stated that he and his wife O2 were in the middle of a divorce. V1 said that he went into Walmart at around 2300 hours and came out about ten minutes later and noticed the trunk had been scratched.
18-37316	Narcotics	Palm Harbor Pkwy (BP gas station)	Deputy was patrolling the Palm Harbor area when she saw 2 females coming from the rear of the closed business toward a parked grey vehicle out front. Contact was made to dispel a possible criminal activity at which time marijuana could be smelled emitting from the vehicle. A search of the vehicle revealed a total of 43.9 grams of marijuana. S1 was arrested for possession of marijuana with intent to distribute and S2 was arrested for possession of marijuana under 20grams. Both were transported to FCDF without incident.
18-37241	Suspicious incident	Kathleen Trail	O1 reported that his daughter O2, had called his wife, O3, stating she loved them and she was going to harm herself and that she was in Clermont. During the investigation O3 remained on the line with O2 while dispatch attempted to locate her. The Orlando Police Department (OPD) made contact with O2 at a Wendy's in Orlando and stated that paramedics are not needed and that she was "ok. No further action was required of FCSO.
18-37249	Domestic Disturbance	Beach Village Circle	O1 stated the two began to argue and O2 broke a lamp in the apartment. O1 stated she wanted O2 to leave and to move out, but he was refusing to leave. O1 decided she would go to a hotel for the evening.
18-37304	Disturbance Physical	Rosewood Street Bunnell	S1 was arrested for battery domestic violence after she was determined to be the primary aggressor of a physical disturbance between S1 and her adult brother.
