Death	19-37633	Bridgehaven Dr	A home care nurse came to check on a patient, but did not get a response at the door or by phone. Deputies could see the female lying on the floor and forced entry was made. Female was pronounced dead by PCFD.
Domestic Disturbance – Physical	19-37667	Richland Pl	S1 and V1 were involved in a physical disturbance reference money. S1 then struck her brother multiple times in the arm with a broom, leaving multiple marks and welts on his arms. S1 was determined to be the primary aggressor and placed under arrest reference Battery DV and transported to FCIF.
Physical Disturbance	19-37680	Prosperity Ln	Altercation between roommates. All parties were intoxicated and refused to cooperate with law enforcement.
Physical Disturbance	19-37717	Wellesley Ln	O1 advised O2 pushed her into a wall and allegedly choked her. O2 advised he did push O1, because they were arguing and O1 began to repeatedly punch O2 in the face. Neither party wanted medical attention nor were there visible injuries on either party.
Baker Act	19-37701	Landing Blvd	Adult male taken into custody for baker act.
Follow up	19-37325	E Moody Blvd. (BP)	RP advised that she was walking home from the family dollar and observed a shiny object in the ditch at the intersection of S Bacher St and E Court St. RP discovered it was a firearm and picked it up with a plastic bag continued to her residence and contacted law enforcement. The gun was placed into evidence.
