Patrol units flooded the area and located the driver inside the restaurant. The suspect was a confirmed occupant of the vehicle by way of surveillance video from McDonalds. The suspect in custody also had a HX of burglary, grand theft auto and fleeing and eluding. Vehicle inventoried and sealed up for processing. Vehicle removed from FCIC/NCIC as stolen.

A large amount of narcotics was recovered from the vehicle and the occupants, one male and one female, were taken into custody and transported to the FCIF.
