As she got in between both parties, she advised she must have fell and hit her face on the ground because she doesn't remember why she was bleeding. O2 assured that no one touched or placed hands on her and refused medical treatment several times. All parties were intoxicated and uncooperative with deputies on scene.

The female also stated that she took "speed" and there were drugs in the camper being towed by their vehicle.
