Arson	20-47412	Palm Coast Pwy NE KAWA SUSHI PLAZA	Dep. Conway and Dep. Cowan were on a traffic stop on Palm Coast Pwy NE by the Taco Shop on a white Ford 4dr with the plate obstructed with cardboard. Employees from the Publix shopping center advised them of a big fire, possibly the building. They cleared the TS and went behind Kawa Sushi to find a dumpster completely engulfed. Being it was the second fire in the area in an hour,(20-47403) several units, including PACE went to the area to BOLO. Video surveillance from Publix showed the vehicle Dep. Conway had stopped in the area of both fires. Contact was made with S1 at his residence and post Miranda he confessed to both fires. He was charged with 2 counts of Arson and 1 count of Fire Bomb.
Arson	20-47403	Belle Terre Pwy CITGO (closed down)	Employees of Publix reported what appeared to be a transient trying to start a campfire. Units arrived to find a small fire (smoldering) on the side of the building, but no transients in the area. They used extinguishers to make sure it was out completely, and noticed an upside down beer bottle, with paper in it against a wood panel. It appeared that the bottle was used, like a Molotov Cocktail to attempt to start the fire. See above for further
Domestic Disturbance	20-47415	Kingswood Dr	S1 reported his wife's Aunt (unk. Name) struck him in the head with a chain due to he and his wife being involved in an argument reference food stamps. While speaking with S1's wife she advised S1 swung a stick at her and the others in the room, and the other parties had left. She provided a written statement that S1 never struck anyone and she was not in fear for her safety but wanted S1 to leave. A DV statement was collected which stated S1 did hit her in the arm with the stick but no injury or visible mark was observed or reported.
