According to O1, O2 struck him and he pushed her away in self defense. The other 4 witnesses had different accounts of what transpired also. The situation was not a domestic situation. Charges were forwarded to the SAO on both parties.
Disturbance verbal – Domestic	19-42704	Roxanne Ln.	V1 and her husband S1 were involved in an altercation. V1 retreated to a closet and advised while she was in the closet she heard what she thought was a gunshot. When Deputies arrived the residence was cleared, and S1 was located in the wood line outside of the home. S1 was taken into custody with no injuries sustained. He was placed under arrest reference Assault-DV and resisting w/o violence.

O2 advised O1 then pushed her, causing her to fall into her dresser. O1 stated all information O2 provided was accurate.
