<b>Crash with Injuries</b>	20-56959	Colbert Lane @ Roberts Road	Deputy observed a Ford Mustang (FL tag# EPBQ61) recklessly driving northbound on Roberts Road without headlights. The vehicle was later located in the wood line at Colbert Lane and Roberts Road. The driver was transported to Halifax hospital for his injuries and FHP responded to handle crash.
<b>Domestic Disturbance</b>	20-56943	Beach Village Cir	V1 reported that S1 began a verbal argument with her over a male contact being on her cell phone. V1 stated that S1 charged at her with scissors and began cutting her hair. V1 then attempted to call 911, but S1 took her cellphone away and then left the area cellphone prior to the arrival of LEO.
<b>Burglary (Vehicle)</b>	20-56910	Blare Drive	The caller reported locating a wallet at the intersection of Farver Lane and Farnum Lane. This was later determined to be a delayed vehicle burglary from Blare Drive. Upon speaking with the victim at Blare Drive it was found that the vehicle was left unlocked overnight with a wallet left inside. Credit cards, a knife and \$6 cash were stolen. The credit cards have since been canceled with no suspicious activity as of the time of this report.
<b>Domestic Disturbance</b>	20-56992	Ferndale Ln	S1 was arrested for simple battery, 2 counts and tampering with a witness after an argument began with his fiances daughter S1 was transported to the FCIF without incident.
