| Disturbance Domestic (w/a Baker Act) | 20-58249 | Old Kings Road South | Juvenile struck her mother during a disturbance and then began harming herself. Female was transported to Halifax by law enforcement. Charges for DV Battery will be forwarded to the SAO for review. |
| Disturbance - Domestic | 20-58257 | Beach Village Cir | Argument between mother and 16 year old daughter. Daughter was being unruly and talking back, and at one point "came at" her mother. This resulted in two brothers getting involved, one coming to the defense of their mother and the other defending their sister. A struggle between the two brothers resulted in the younger brother's shirt being ripped. All children involved were juveniles. No injuries were reported with the exception of a small welt on the 16 year old. It was determined that the mother's actions were in an effort to discipline her daughter, whom mom describes as "out of control." Mother decided to stay with her boyfriend to allow things to calm down. |
| Disturbance Domestic | 20-58276 | Wedgewood Ln | S1 was involved in a verbal argument with her boyfriend S2 due to his infidelity. S1 became angry and slapped S2 in his face. In return, S1 threw S2 into her pool and struck her multiple times before leaving the scene in S1's gray Mazda 3. Charges for simple battery DV were completed against S1 and submitted to the SAO. Charges for simple battery DV and grand theft auto were completed against S2 and left at the PCDO if located. |
| Missing Juvenile | 20-58208 | Post Tree Ln | Juvenile left home after an argument with her parents. After nearly 4 hours, she still had not returned home and her parents became nervous. Juvenile was eventually located in the W section walking along the roadway. |
