Disturbance Physical – Aggravated Battery	51877-19	Sedgwick Trail	S1 was involved in a an altercation with his aunt, V1, over ownership of a vehicle. S1 struck V1 numerous times in the face causing her eyes to swell completely shut, her mouth and nose to bleed, as well as cuts and abrasions throughout her body. V1 was able to escape the residence but collapsed in the front yard of a neighbor’s residence where she was located and transported to Advent Health. S1 was placed under arrest for aggravated battery and resisting arrest without violence.
Disturbance Physical	51905-19	Warwick Place	S1 placed under arrest for battery after striking his neighbor in the face during a dispute.
JPC	19-51943	Bunker Knolls	At 22:12 the juvenile was home and in compliance.
Baker Act	19-51946	Elder Street	An adult female was placed in custody under a baker act after making suicidal statements following a verbal disturbance at this same address. Female was cooperative and transported to CTTU. Deputy Green
Marchman Act	19-51948	Winchester Road	Adult female appeared to have overdosed on heroin and went unconscious, however she was alert and conscious upon LEO arrival. Female was placed in custody under a Marchman Act and was transported to Advent Health for medical clearance by rescue.
Disturbance (Domestic)	19-51988	Intersection of Mahogany Blvd and Rosewood St	The victim reported that her boyfriend, S1 of three months punched her in the left eye area during an argument inside of a friend’s vehicle. S1 was located and placed under arrest for domestic battery (dating violence).
Criminal Mischief	19-52006	Grove Street	A neighbor reported to the homeowner that the grass near the fence in the front yard was on fire. The neighbor witnessed this through their video surveillance that only live streams and does not record. The fire was extinguished quickly and little to no damage was done.
