18-73649	Larceny	Palm Coast Parkway NW	V1 stated that her cell phone was picked up by a transient, and sold to O1. Gabriel has been in contact with O1 but he has yet to return the cell phone. The phone was entered as stolen in FCIC/NCIC.
18-73629	Disturbance Domestic	Slumber Meadow Trail	Disturbance between boyfriend and girlfriend during which time both became involved in a tugging match over a child. Charges submitted to SAO for review due to being unable to determine aggressor.
18-73686	Disturbance Domestic	Frontier Dr	V1 stated that her husband S1 are in the process of getting a divorce. V1 arrived home from work, went inside the house while using her cell phone when S1 snatched her cell phone from her hand. V1 attempted to get her cell phone back from S1, S1 subsequently placed both of his hands on V1 chest and pushed her into a wall, after she hit the wall she fell to the ground. S1 was arrested and charged with domestic battery.
18-73629	Disturbance Physical	Slumber Meadow Drive	During a one year birthday party for the couples daughter s1 and s2 were involved in a verbal dispute and s1 told s2 to leave her house. During the altercation s2 and s1 are both attempting to retain control of the child and involved in a tug of war situation, DCF was notified. A primary aggressor could not be determined. Charging affidavits forwarded on s2 and s1 for child abuse due to the couple struggling with the child, charging affidavit forwarded on s1 for battery due to physical altercation with s2.
18-73734	Disturbance Domestic	Old Kings Road (Bowling Alley)	Units responded to the Bowling Alley reference an intoxicated male that was being disorderly s1 engaged in a verbal altercation outside the building with patrons then began to break glass beer bottles on a wooden table. s1 was arrested and charged with battery and a Flagler VOP misdemeanor warrant.
18-73273	Disturbance Domestic	Water Oak Road	S1 was involved in a verbal dispute with his girlfriend of four years, V1. S1 became enraged at V1 and grabbed a glass ashtray and threw it at her head. V1 was able to dodge the ashtray and avoided being struck by it. S1 also threatened V1 and putting a well founded fear for V1 safety. S1 was placed under arrest reference aggravated assault domestic.
