O2 stated he did not punch O1 and the argument was only verbal. Both subjects were intoxicated and agreed to stay away from each other. O2 stated he was going to sleep somewhere else for the night and did not want to sign charges.
18-88894	Disturbance Domestic	Milwaukee Ave	V1) stated her boyfriend, S1 came home intoxicated. V1 stated she did not want S1 in the house and they began to argue on the front porch. V1 stated S1 pushed her to the ground during the argument. V1 had small scraps on both elbows and dirt on her knees. S1 was placed under arrest for DV battery.
