| 89454-18 | Stolen Vehicle Recovered | I-95 from St. John's Count | Dispatch received a phone call from V1 who is the fleet manager for Exclusive Global Logistics, advising that he was in Jacksonville waiting for JSO to respond to his location to report two of his car haulers stolen from his location. After an extensive search, VCSO K-9 with FCSO made contact with S1 in the woods. S2 was located on I-95 and arrested. Rescue responded to the scene for a dog bite. S1 was placed under arrest for grand theft motor vehicle and resisting arrest without violence. |
| 89451-18 | Baker Act | Regent Lane | Littlefield reported that his wife, S1 held a 9mm handgun to her head during a verbal argument. O1 exited the residence and contact was made with S1 by telephone who was directed out of the residence without incident. She was placed under a Baker Act and transported to CTTU. |
| 89471-18 | Baker Act | Biltmore Place | Juvenile placed under a Baker Act and transported to Halifax Hospital. |
| 89472-18 | Domestic Disturbance | Riddle Drive | S1 was arrested for DV battery after having a physical confrontation with O1. O1 completed a sworn written statement advising S1 threw a standing fan at her, which caused a laceration/swelling to her left temple. |
| 89473-18 | Agency Vehicle Crash | Bird of Paradise Drive | Deputy was involved in a minor accident while responding to a suicide threats call for service. |
