89840-18	Larceny –Grand theft (Baker Act)	Westmount Lane	V1 advised that s1 was on scene at the residence, had stolen his jewelry, and pawned it at unknown pawn shops. Contact with made with s1 who admitted to pawning items and stated he had also taken (12) 30mg oxycodone pills. A note was also located written by him with suicidal statements. S1 was placed under a Baker Act and transported to FHF due to taking the multiple pills.
18-89915	Domestic Battery	Freneau Ln	S1 arrived home drunk and started arguing with his mother. Father, v1, woke up and tried to get s1 to calm down. During this interaction s1 struck v1 with a closed fist which caused v1 to have a bloody nose. S1 was arrested and transported to the Flagler County Detention Facility without incident.
89107-18	Stolen Vehicle (recovered)	Palm Coast Pkwy NW	FCSO conducted a traffic stop on a white truck bearing Florida tag 314VRJ. During the traffic stop, a red Yamaha Scooter missing a tag, was observed in the bed of the truck. The VIN was ran and it was determined it was stolen from Publix Town Center on 09-20-18. S1 initially advised the scooter belonged to him. The tag was not located. Also in the vehicle was numerous narcotics but that investigation is pending evidence processing. S2 listed below was not in the vehicle but approached units on scene when it was determined that he had a warrant and was placed under arrest. The owner of the scooter was contacted and it was turned over to him on scene. S1 was placed under arrest for grand theft auto and DWLS with knowledge.

Video shows a suspect use an object to break the glass at approximately 2:08am, enter with a trash can, fill it with approximately \$3,000.00 worth of cigarettes, and exit the store at approximately 2:11am. The suspect was wearing a black mask and gloves. The MO was the same as prior incidents in the county. The alarm for unknown reasons did not activate.
89927-18	Intoxication	Palm Coast Pkwy NW (Chic Fil A)	Dispatch received a call that a naked male was chasing after people and a vehicle in the Chic Fila A parking lot. Upon arrival, Deputies observed the male naked and approaching another individual in an aggressive manner. The male was secured at that time without incident. He would not identify himself, appeared to be under the influence of an unknown narcotic, and was very uncooperative. The witnesses of the indecent exposure did not want to pursue charges. The male was placed under arrest for disorderly conduct and obstruction and cleared at FHF.
