

RESOLUTION 2024-59

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLAGLER BEACH, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE FLAGLER COUNTY SHERIFF MANAGE THE SR 100 BRIDGE OPERATIONS, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2024 by Executive Order Number 24-156, Governor Ron DeSantis declared a State of Emergency for 51 counties in the State of Florida due to the imminent approach of Tropical Storm Milton which is forecasted to become a major hurricane and strike Florida's West Coast; and

WHEREAS; on October 7, 2024 the Flagler County Board of County Commissioners adopted a Proclamation declaring a State of Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City Official's and staff are following the orders and recommendations of the Florida Division of Emergency Management, and our County Emergency Manager, and

WHEREAS, the health safety and welfare of the City of Flagler Beach residents, businesses, and visitors and staff is of the utmost importance to the City, additional future measures may be needed to protect the community, and to enable the City to respond to situations it is necessary to waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the City; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLAGLER BEACH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Commission of the City of Flagler Beach, does hereby, request the Flagler County Sheriff exercise appropriate measures after consultation with Flagler Beach Officials regarding the State Road 100 bridge operations.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its execution.


