**NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK THE DEATH PENALTY AND  
LIST OF AGGRAVATING FACTORS**

COMES NOW, R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, by and through the undersigned Assistant State Attorney, and hereby gives notice of the state's intent to seek the death penalty against the defendant. The state intends to prove and has reason to believe it can prove beyond a reasonable doubt the following aggravating factors:

1. The capital felony was committed by a person previously convicted of a felony and under sentence of imprisonment or placed on community control or on felony probation.
2. The defendant was previously convicted of another capital felony or of a felony involving the use or threat of violence to the person.
3. The capital felony was especially heinous, atrocious, or cruel.
4. The capital felony was a homicide and was committed in a cold, calculated, and premeditated manner without any pretense of moral or legal justification.
