traveling south on Belle Terre Pkwy from the scene of the incident. The vehicle was occupied by 5 males. Sgt Gimbel initiated a high risk traffic stop. Several Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) deputies assisted with the stop. The occupants were subsequently identified as follows:

- Driver: Calix Nasukiewicz
- Front Passenger: Jamey Bennett (AKA: JuJu)
- Rear Driver's Side: Randy Alexandre
- Rear Middle Seat: Jaylan Moronta
- Rear Passenger: Paul Pajotte (AKA: Paulo)

Once the 5 subjects were secured in restraints, Corporal DeSousa approached the vehicle, and looked through the windows and open doors to determine if there were other occupants in the vehicle. He did not see any other occupants but noticed the muzzles of two handguns protruding from both the front driver's and passenger's side seats.

The vehicle was secured as a crimes scene, and the 5 occupants were kept separate from one another. Paul was found to have an active warrant for his arrest and was placed under arrest in reference to that warrant.

Deputy Lane responded to the scene. Upon arrival, he spoke to several neighbors in the area who advised they heard gunshots, and spoke to the resident of 34 Kalamazoo Trail [REDACTED]

Revelations advised she was on the phone with her cousin (Corwin Butler). Corwin advised Terrance Broome he had been in an argument with some acquaintances, only identified as Jamey Bennett and John Kingston and stated they wanted to meet up and fight Terrance. Corwin did not provide any further detail as to what the argument was about. A large amount of shell casings were located on the ground and identified as 9mm and .22 caliber.

██████████ was in the home at the time of the shooting and is pregnant. Several rounds penetrated the home as well as a white Chevrolet Cruz that was parked in the driveway.

A crime scene was established. Dep Lane also made contact with the original reporting party, (Dalton Burns), at 18 Kalamazoo Trail. Dalton stated he observed three passengers which he described as a silver in color four door sedan. Dalton was only able to describe the driver, who was possibly a younger black male, unknown height/build, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with white lettering on it, a blue surgical mask, unknown color pants and shoes. Dalton advised the hood was on the unknown individual's head and did not get a good look at any of their faces. Dalton could only provide that the other two individuals within the vehicle were wearing black hooded sweat shirts and were both sitting in the back seat. Dalton advised they were parked in the roadway outside his house and when other vehicles would pass by, they would duck down, which aroused Dalton's suspicion.

Dalton further advised the passengers of the vehicle got out of the car multiple times to either open the driver's door and at one point retrieved an unknown item from the trunk. Dalton advised this is when he noticed two of the individuals get out of the vehicle and started heading towards the higher numbers of Kalamazoo Trail on foot. Dalton advised he heard multiple gun shots and then saw the vehicle perform a u-turn shortly after and leave the area. He was unable to provide any further information.

A sworn written statement was collected from Dalton and will be submitted into records. Deputy Lane utilized his Taser Axon body camera. Footage will be uploaded to Evidence.com.

Numerous video and audio segments were obtained from neighboring residences with home surveillance systems. One video depicts the aforementioned silver Ford Fusion with the relevant footage described below:

All dates and times are representative of the timestamp on the video in question



- Suspect vehicle comes to a complete stop in front of victim's residence on 01/28/2021 at 06:48:47pm.
- First muzzle flash visible from the front passenger side of vehicle on 01/28/2021 at 06:48:48pm.
- Separate muzzle flash visible from passenger side of suspect vehicle closer to the rear of suspect vehicle on 01/28/2021 at 06:48:49pm.
- Driver side rear passenger door opens and suspect emerges from vehicle and numerous muzzle flashes visible on 01/28/2021 at 06:48:49pm.
- Vehicle disembarks from stopped location in front of victim's residence on 01/28/2021 at 06:48:57pm.

The videos will be collected and submitted to evidence.

Sergeant Miller was contacted at this time, as the on-call Investigative Services Division (ISD) investigator. He responded to the scene of the traffic stop and requested assistance from various other investigators.

Sergeant Miller made contact with Corporal DeSousa. Corporal DeSousa accompanied Sergeant Miller as he made contact with the 5 suspects who had been detained and separated. Sergeant Miller read each subject their Miranda Rights, and each person indicated they understood those rights and were willing to waive those rights and speak with investigators. Sergeant Miller also advised each subject why they were detained and that he wanted to talk to each of them, but since it was about 43 degrees Fahrenheit out, and there was a limited number of vehicles with prisoner compartments, he would prefer for them to voluntarily be transported from the scene, to the courthouse so those interviews could be conducted indoors. Only Paul Pajotte agreed to be transported. The others were advised they would be held, on scene, under reasonable suspicion that they had been involved in a shooting. They were also advised if the investigation cleared them of any wrong-doing, they would be released at that time. All of this was recorded by Corporal

DeSousa utilizing his Taser Axon body camera. The video will be uploaded to evidence.com.

Sergeant Hristakopoulos and Corporal Rodriguez responded to 34 Kalamazoo Trl with Crime Scene Investigator (CSI) Wardman. In all, 35 shell casings were recovered from the scene.

- 6 (six) .22 CCI cartridge cases ON SCENE
- 1 (one) .22 Winchester Super X cartridge case ON SCENE
- 1 (one) .22 Winchester Super X cartridge case TRUNK OF FORD FUSION
- 27 (twenty-seven) 9mm Luger CCI cartridge cases ON SCENE

Several slugs were also recovered, embedded in various parts of the home.


Detective Castanheira began completing a search warrant for the aforementioned Ford Fusion.

The search warrant was signed and executed on the Ford Fusion. Five cell phones were recovered from the vehicle. In all 3 firearms were recovered:

- A .22 caliber Glock from under the front passenger seat.
- A .22 Caliber Walther from under the front passenger seat.
- And a Glock 19x with an extended magazine from under the driver's seat.
- A box of .22 CCI ammunition was recovered from the vehicle.

Sergeant Miller and Detective Dawson interviewed Calix Nasukiewicz first. Several subsequent interviews were conducted with Calix as the investigation revealed more evidence. The interviews were captured through a combination of Taser Axon video from patrol deputies, iRecord video system, and Detective Dawson's and Sergeant Miller's Digital Audio-Recorders (DAT). The relevant portion of those interviews is summarized as follows:

- Calix and Jaylan reside together at Calix's residence (27 Rymen Drive, Palm Coast, Flagler



  - Paul (Left Rear Passenger).
- Calix parked in the area of 35 Kalamazoo Trail and met with a White Male named Jason, who was operating a Black in Color Jeep Cherokee with a White Female passenger.
- All parties exited their vehicle and engaged in conversation and a game plan.
- The conversation was in reference to Terrance and Jamey (JuJu) fighting and Terrance being evasive.



- Jaylan has been living with Calix's family in the R-Section.

- They five aforementioned suspects traveled to the residence because Jamey wanted to fight one of the resident's.
- The resident's were joking about a family member of Paul and Jamey's that passed away.
- As they were trying to set up the fight between Jamey and the resident, the resident would not advise his location.
- According to Paul, Randy advised "I did not come all this way for nothing. We are shooting up the house."
- Paul stated he had a P22, Randy had a Glock and Jamey had a Glock.
- When they approached the residence, Paul, Jamey and Randy exited the vehicle and shot at the residence of 34 Kalamazoo Trail.
- Paul advised his gun jammed after 2 or 3 rounds.
- After the shooting, the three subjects got back into the vehicle and Calix drove away.
- Shortly after the shooting they were stopped by law enforcement.
- Paul advised the three guns were still in the vehicle.

Sergeant Michael Miller and Corporal Agustin Rodriguez, conducted a series of post-Miranda interview with Randy Alexandre (B/M - 10/18/1999). 

- Randy was recently made aware of the fact that Juju had been "jumped" by approximately 15 people during a fight in Palm Coast.
- That incident stemmed from a disagreement between Juju and his friend "Simba" (Terrance Broome).
- Simba and Juju have been going back and forth on social media about this incident and that there had been various threats leveled from both sides.
- Simba had been bad mouthing his recently deceased cousin on social media, which upset him deeply.
- Randy stated that Juju getting "jumped" by several people bothered him as well and that he wanted to fight Simba one-on-one.
- Randy, Juju, "Paulo" (Paul P. Pajotte), Jaylan, and Calix all travelled to the area of Simba's house in an effort to have Randy fight Simba on behalf of Jamey.
- Randy brought his own gun, a Glock 19 with an extended "clip".
- Paul was also in possession of a gun and he believed it was a small .22 caliber pistol with older looking ammunition in it.
- Jamey "Juju" was also in possession of a gun, that he believed it was a "Glock" .22 caliber pistol.

- Randy told the group he "did not come all the way up there for nothing."
- He then decided that they were going to "spray" the house (Street terminology for shooting many bullets at something).
- Randy stated that the seating arrangement in the vehicle, at the time the shooting took place, was as follows:
  - Calix - Driver
  - Juju - Front Passenger
  - Randy - Rear Driver Side Passenger
  - Jaylan - Rear Center Passenger
  - Paul - Rear Passenger Side Passenger
- Calix drove up to Simba's residence and stopped right in front.
- Randy exited the vehicle via the rear driver side door and began firing rounds from his Glock handgun.
- Randy stated that he knew Paul had fired rounds from his gun, but that he could not be positive that Juju fired any rounds.



- The fight was stemming from a disagreement between him and his former close friend, "Simba" (Terrance Broome).
- Jamey's sneakers were stolen during the "jumping" and Simba had been taunting him on social media by posting pictures of him with the shoes.
- Jamey and Simba had been going back and forth on social media, levying threats towards each other frequently.
- Jamey's girlfriend's cousins, "Randy and Paul" came to Palm Coast to help him with the Simba situation.
- Randy was driving a silver Ford that he had rented.
- Randy expressed that he wanted to fight Simba one-on-one.

- Randy then hatched the plan for them to drive up to Simba's house and then "spray" it (Street terminology for shooting many bullets at something).

- Jamey was also in possession of a firearm; a Glock .22 caliber handgun that was loaned to him by Calix via Calix's brother.

- Jamey exited the vehicle and began firing rounds from his Glock handgun.
- Jamey was aiming exclusively at the vehicle that was in the driveway of the residence.
- Randy and Paul were firing rounds from their guns as well.
- Jamey was unsure what Randy or Paul were aiming at.
- He also explained that he did not know that the house was occupied.
- After all the rounds were fired, the men re-entered the vehicle and fled the area with Calix
