The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above named defendant, on the <u>1st</u> day of <u>June</u> , 2018, at approximately <u>7:37</u> <input type="checkbox"/> a.m. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> p.m. at <u>705 North Bacher St, Bunnell FL</u> , within <u>Flagler</u> County, violated the law and did then and there:					
On June 1, 2018 at approximately 1937 hours, I was dispatched to 705 N Bacher St, in reference to a shooting. While en-route to this location Flagler County Dispatch advised the reporting person, later identified as Tammy Almond, accidentally shot her boyfriend.					
When I arrived on scene I asked Flagler County Dispatch to have Tammy step out of the residence with her hands up. After asking Flagler County Dispatch for this request, Tammy exited the residence with her hands up. When Tammy exited the residence, I asked Tammy if she had any weapons on her, and if there was any one else inside the residence and she replied, "Just Darryl, he's lying on the floor and there's blood everywhere." I then asked Tammy if Darryl and she were fighting and she replied, "I don't know. I just picked up the gun and didn't think it was loaded and it just shot." Once Tammy advised me that nobody else was inside the residence, I approached the residence. As I approached the residence I opened the front door, and then yelled Darryl's name into the residence. When I yelled Darryl's name, Tammy stated, "He's unresponsive."					
When Corporal Barile with the Flagler Sheriff's Office arrived on scene I entered the residence. As I entered the residence I observed a white male, personally known to me as Darryl Wilson, in the dining room area lying on his back with his head facing north, and feet facing south. I noticed blood

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

coming from Darryl's nose and mouth, and a large amount of blood on the floor around his head. After noticing Darryl lying on the floor, I put my hand on his chest and yelled his name, but he did not respond. After Darryl didn't respond, I checked to see if he was breathing or had a pulse. As I checked Darryl I noticed he wasn't breathing and didn't have a pulse. After checking Darryl, I began checking his person to see where he was struck. While checking Darryl, Flagler County Fire Rescue arrived on scene and pronounced Darryl deceased at 1945 hours.

After Darryl was pronounced deceased, a crime scene was established. Once a crime scene was established, Sgt. Miller and Detective Ebrill with the Flagler County Sheriff's Office responded to assist with the investigation. When Sgt. Miller and Detective Ebrill responded to the scene, Tammy agreed to be interviewed, so she was transported to the Flagler County Sheriff's Operation Center. While at the Flagler County Operation Center, Tammy was interviewed by Detective Ebrill and Detective D. Sanders with the State Attorneys Homicide unit.

During the interview, Tammy was read her Miranda rights. Post Miranda Tammy advised Darryl and she are boyfriend and girlfriend. Tammy advised Darryl and she have been dating in an "on again off again" relationship for approximately three years. Tammy advised that Darryl and she were at this location today because Darryl was house sitting for someone. Tammy advised while inside the residence she located a rifle sitting behind the front door. Tammy advised when she located the rifle she picked it up and began manipulating it while standing at the front door. Tammy advised while manipulating the rifle, she raised it up, and pulled the hammer back. Tammy advised after pulling the hammer back, Darryl was walking through the kitchen, and yelled, "Bang". Tammy advised when Darryl yelled "Bang", she pulled the trigger on the rifle, causing it to discharge. Tammy advised after the rifle discharged, Darryl dropped to the ground. Tammy advised when Darryl dropped to the ground she ran over to check on him, and noticed a lot of blood around his head. Tammy advised at this time she reached into Darryl's front pocket, grabbed his cell phone, and called 911.

During the interview Tammy was asked if she was startled when Darryl yelled, "Bang", and she replied, "No." Tammy was asked if she intentionally pulled the trigger on the firearm and she indicated, "yes." Tammy also added she is familiar with firearms and she "knew better."
