On August 6, 2019 at approximately 1437 hours, members of the Bunnell Police Department were dispatched to a juvenile incident at 4600 E Moody Blvd building 5. While en-route to the location the reporting person, later identified as Angel Martinez (O1), advised a maintenance worker located a juvenile male, who appeared to be approximately one years old, running around the parking lot naked. When I arrived on scene, I made contact with Angel, Keon Brewer, and the three-year-old juvenile male, who was later identified as Kayden Bruder, in front of building 5.

When I made contact with Angel he advised while exiting his vehicle he was approached by Keon. Angel advised when Keon approached him, he advised him of the incident, and then asked if he knew where Kayden lived. Angel advised while speaking to Keon he recognized Kayden and knew that he lived in apartment 5A. Angel advised after recognizing Kayden, he called law enforcement to report the incident. Angel advised while waiting for law enforcement to arrive on scene his girlfriend provided Kayden with a large shirt to wear.

When I made contact with Keon, he advised he was at the property doing yard maintenance when he observed Kayden running up around in the parking lot, naked, with his hands over his ears. Keon advised when he walked up to Kayden, he asked him where he lived at which time Kayden ran back to his residence, which is apartment 5A. Keon advised after Kayden ran back to his residence, he continued to do his maintenance duties. Keon advised as he continued his maintenance, he noticed Kayden was following him. Keon advised when he noticed Kayden was following him, he followed Kayden back to his residence and knocked on the door several times. Keon advised when he knocked on the door several times nobody answered, the door partially opened so he yelled into the residence. Keon advised after receiving no response he began searching the area to find the parent. Keon advised while searching the area he made contact with Angel, at which time Angel advised him that Kayden lives in apartment 5A. Keon advised after it was determined where Kayden lived, Angel called 911 to report the incident. Keon further advised the time lapse from when he first saw Kayden until the time law enforcement was called was approximately 30 minutes.

After speaking to Keon, Officer Baker and I attempted to make contact with the occupants of apartment 5A. As I approached the door, I knocked on it several times at which time the door opened. After the door opened, Kayden entered the residence and ran in to the back bedroom. When Kayden entered the residence, I announced "police" several times, and then I announced, "hello" several times. After receiving no response after approximately 45 seconds of making announcements, I feared the occupants could be suffering some type

of medical issue, so I entered the residence. As I entered the residence, I observed a white female personally known to me as Amber Bruder, exiting the back bedroom. As Amber exited the back bedroom, I advised her the reason why we were at the location, and then asked why her son was outside unsupervised. When I asked this question, Amber refused to answer but continued to walk towards me. When Amber got close to me, she forcefully pushed me with one hand, and yelled "Get out" as she attempted to close the door with the other hand. After Amber pushed me, she was subsequently secured in handcuffs.

After Amber was secured in handcuffs, Officer Baker and I conducted a cursory of the residence for any other children/occupants. During the cursory search Officer Baker located an infant, later identified as Kaya Bruder (DOB 06-02-19) laying face down on the bed, with a pillow partially covering her head. When Officer Baker noticed Kaya laying in the bed facedown, with a pillow partially covering her head, she immediately checked on her well-being by picking her up. When Officer Baker picked Kaya up it was discovered that she was only sleeping and the diaper she was wearing was completely soiled in body waste.

After completing the cursory search, I walked Amber and Kayden out to my patrol vehicle. While walking out to my patrol vehicle, I noticed Kayden was not wearing shoes, so I picked him up to prevent him from burning his feet. When I bent over to pick Kayden up it caused my AXON BWC to temporarily turn off. While at the rear of my patrol vehicle I read Amber her Miranda rights from a department issued Miranda Card. Post Miranda Amber refused to speak with me and refused to provide me with Kayden and Kaya's complete personal information.

While Officer Baker and I completed our investigation, I placed Amber, Kayden, and Kaya in the air condition within the prisoner compartment of my patrol vehicle. While Amber, Kayden, and Kaya were in the prisoner compartment of my patrol vehicle I took several digital photos to show the condition inside of the residence. While taking photos I noticed trash throughout the residence, with empty beer and liquor bottles within the bedroom that Amber exited. After taking several photos, I contacted The Department of Children and Families, and spoke to Lyn ID # 362. When I spoke to Lyn, she advised an investigator would be responding to the incident.

Based off the statements provided by both witnesses and the fact that Kayden was discovered roaming a busy parking lot, completely naked without supervision for approximately 30 minutes, I placed Amber under arrest for child neglect and battery on a law enforcement officer.

After placing Amber under arrest, Officer Baker and I transported Amber, Kayden and Kaya back to the Bunnell Police Department. While at the Bunnell Police Department Kaya and Kayden were turned over to Officer Baker to wait for the arrival of the DCF investigator. After turning the children over to Officer Baker, I transported Amber to the Flagler County Jail for processing. While at the Jail, Amber began acting lethargic, and refused to answer the jail deputies' questions. Do to Ambers condition they requested she be transported to Advent Health for medical clearance. While at Advent Health, Amber was initially uncooperative and refused to answer the questions being asked by the medical professionals. After several attempts to obtain information, Amber admitted to the nurse that she was not under any controlled substance and that she was intoxicated. When the nurse asked Amber how much she had to drink she replied, "Too much". After Amber was cleared from the hospital, she was transported back to the Flagler County Jail for processing.

While I was at the hospital with Amber, Officer Baker advised me the DCF investigator arrived on scene and took possession of the children.

During this incident, Officer Baker and I were wearing Bunnell Police Department Uniforms, which are equipped with "Bunnell Police Department" patches, and we were both wearing gun belts, which are equipped with a firearm, handcuffs, a police radio, and other law enforcement tools.

All evidence was tagged into property and evidence at the Bunnell Police Department.
