Intent to Provide Formal Discipline

Based on the sustained findings of FCSO Internal Investigation 2018-009, it is the intention of the FCSO to discipline you for sustained violations of FCSO General Orders.

A sustained violation of FCSO General Order 020-Standards of Conduct; Personnel will obey the policies, procedures, instructions and directives of the Sheriff. This is a category 9 violation.

A sustained violation of FCSO General Order 020-Standards of Conduct; Truthfulness: Personnel shall truthfully relay all information and answer all questions related to their employment with the agency, off-duty employment, volunteer activities with the agency, or questions otherwise related to Sheriff's Office operations, that are asked by, or provided to the Sheriff, the Sheriff's designee, or a superior officer. Personnel shall truthfully answer any questions during any legal proceeding, or otherwise under oath. This is a category 10 violation.

A sustained violation of FCSO General Order 020-Standards of Conduct; Personnel will not falsify any document, record, statement, report or communication. This is a category 10 violation.

Recommended Disciplinary Action: Termination

All of the above proposed discipline will be effective on Friday May 4th at 4:00pm.
