

| NARRATIVE | Narrative Title: Narrative |
| | 1. On Thursday, August 3, 2023, Ofc. Meineke and I responded to 2301 S. Atlantic Ave to assist Ofc. Ransom and Ofc. Epling who were on scene investigating a disturbance. |

| | 4. Upon arrival, I contacted one half of the disturbance who was sitting outside 2301 S. Atlantic Ave speaking to Ofc. Ransom. The female, identified as [REDACTED], was visibly upset and crying. She stated she and her girlfriend, Jacqueline Blank, got into an argument while traveling in their vehicle. |
| | 5. [REDACTED] accused Jacqueline Blank of being drunk and addicted to drugs and claimed when she told Jacqueline Blank of some upsetting news she learned this morning, an argument ensued. [REDACTED] |
| | 6. [REDACTED] stated she wanted Jacqueline Blank to "hold her" because she was upset, but Jacqueline Blank instead grabbed [REDACTED] by her shirt, pulled her hair and grabbed her by her necklace. [REDACTED] |
| | 7. [REDACTED] first stated this took place outside of a police station somewhere, but she could not specify where. |
| | 8. Later, she stated the physical fight started when Jacqueline Blank pulled into 2301 S. Atlantic Ave. |
| | 9. Both women got out of the vehicle and the verbal fight continued in the parking lot. The front desk clerk, Marissa Feichtl, stated she heard [REDACTED] and Jacqueline Blank arguing outside, and then the two women came into the hotel lobby and got into some kind of physical "lock" or hold with each other. Marissa Feichtl then called the police. Two guests of the hotel also witnessed this incident and completed sworn, written affidavits. |

| 12. While I was speaking with [REDACTED] I noticed she had visible marks on both sides of her neck and a black burn type injury from the black cord her necklace was made of. The collar of her shirt | |


21. was also stretched out, and she had a scratch on the outside of her right arm that appeared to be fresh.
 22. [REDACTED] also had a visible injury below her left eye and, when I asked her about it, she stated
 23. it was from Jacqueline Blank punching her a week ago. [REDACTED] stated Jacqueline Blank is constantly
 24. violent with her and continually batters her. She also stated Jacqueline Blank had isolated her from
 25. her friends and family and brought her to Florida. [REDACTED] admitted to punching Jacqueline
 26. Blank in the face while the two were fighting. [REDACTED] claimed it was in self-defense.
 27.
 28. After I spoke to [REDACTED] I went inside the lobby where Ofc. Epling was speaking to Jacqueline
 29. Blank. Jacqueline Blank had a visible hematoma to her left eye but stated she was never physical with
 30. [REDACTED]. Jacqueline Blank denied injuring [REDACTED] and claimed she injured herself.
 31. While conducting my investigation, Jacqueline Blank became defensive and non-compliant with my instructions.
 32. Ultimately, Ofc. Epling was able to return her to her seat while we spoke about the incident.
 33.
 34. After conferring with the staff and additional officers on scene, I determined that probable cause
 35. existed for disorderly conduct at a public lodging establishment, as evidenced by the physical fight
 36. inside the lobby which was witnessed by staff and hotel guests. When Ofc. Epling and I instructed Jacqueline
 37. Blank to place her belongings down, she immediately began to resist. Simultaneously, Ofc. Meineke secured
 38. [REDACTED] who immediately began to resist, ran inside, and told Jacqueline Blank to "run". After
 39. a brief physical struggle with Jacqueline Blank, I followed as she ran on foot toward the pool deck.
 40. I deployed my department issued Taser 7, but Jacqueline Blank continued to run. Ofc. Epling then deployed
 41. her department issued Taser 7 twice, and Jacqueline Blank continued to run away from us. Jacqueline
 42. Blank ran around the building towards a side entrance to the lobby where I deployed my second Taser
 43. 7 cartridge, but Jacqueline Blank continued to run away from officers. Jacqueline Blank entered the
 44. side door of the lobby and attempted to lock officers out, but Ofc. Ransom was able to pry the door
 45. open before she could lock it. Jacqueline Blank fell onto the floor and continued to resist Ofc. Ransom,
 46. Ofc. Epling, and I while we were trying to secure her in handcuffs. I deployed my Taser 7 in drive-stun
 47. mode to achieve pain compliance several times until Jacqueline Blank was secured. While I deployed
 48. my Taser 7 in drive-stun mode, Jacqueline Blank attempted to grab my weapon out of my hand but was
 49. unsuccessful. Even after Jacqueline Blank was secured in handcuffs, she continued to kick me. I requested
 50. Sgt. Rademacher respond to the scene and secondary restraints were applied. Jacqueline Blank requested
 51. to be taken at the hospital due being exposed to the Taser on her "metal leg". Ofc. Ransom transported
 52. Jacqueline Blank to Halifax Hospital Port Orange for medical clearance.
 53.
 54. After completing my investigation, I was unable to determine the primary aggressor in reference
 55. to the battery (DV). Both [REDACTED] and Jacqueline Blank were arrested for battery (DV) and disorderly
 56. conduct on a public lodging establishment. [REDACTED] was additionally charged with resisting
 57. an officer without violence. Jacqueline Blank was additionally charged with resisting an officer with
 58. violence and battery on a law enforcement officer. The required domestic violence paperwork was completed
 59. for both Jacqueline Blank and [REDACTED]. They were both provided with domestic violence Victim's
 60. Rights pamphlets.

 62. No one was injured while securing Jacqueline Blank. Photographs were taken of both Jacqueline Blank
 63. and [REDACTED]. Additionally, photographs were also taken of me, Ofc. Ransom, and Ofc. Epling.

 66. Jacqueline Blank was additionally charged with possession of narcotics, possession of paraphernalia,
 67. and tampering with evidence. See Ofc. Ransom's supplement to this report for additional information.

 70. [REDACTED] was transported to the DBSDPS for processing and later to the VCBJ.
 71.
 72. After medical clearance was obtained, Jacqueline Blank was transported to the VCBJ.

 74. This incident was captured on my department issued AXON BWC. See also Sgt. Rademacher, Ofc. Ransom,
 75. Ofc. Epling, and Ofc. Meineke's BWC footage.
