The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant, on the 25th day of October, 2025, at approximately 01:07 hours at 3775 ROSCOMMON DR, Ormond Beach, FL, violated the law and did then and there:

Narrative Title: Narrative

On October 25th, 2025, at approximately 0125 hours, the Volusia Sheriff's Office (VSO) was dispatched to 3795 Roscommon Drive, Ormond Beach (the 7-11 convenience store) regarding a shooting that occurred in the parking lot of the neighboring business located at 3775 Roscommon Drive, Ormond Beach (Fairchild Oaks Dental Care). Upon arrival, VSO Deputy J. Adele contacted the reporting party, Francis Aggar.

Aggar, who is an employee at the 7-11, said he observed three (3) vehicles that appeared to be chasing each other. Aggar said the vehicles were two (2) sedans and one (1) pickup truck. Aggar advised one of sedans was eventually boxed in by the pickup truck and the other sedan in the parking lot of Fairchild Oaks Dental Care. Aggar stated the boxed in sedan attempted to escape from being restricted by backing into the pickup truck and then forward into the other sedan. Aggar advised that once the sedan escaped, it began to drive away, and he (Aggar) heard two (2) gun shots come from the area. Aggar completed a sworn written statement pertaining to the incident.

Deputies then contacted Christopher Harter who also witnessed the incident. Harter described one of the sedans as being black and that a blue truck had chased it into the parking lot (i.e., Fairchild Oaks Dental Care). Then, a silver sedan, along with the blue truck, boxed the black car in. The black car was sandwiched by the silver car in the front and the blue truck behind it (i.e., the black car). Harter advised now that the black car was boxed in, approximately ten (10) to fifteen (15) juveniles surrounded the vehicle. In response to being surrounded, the black car began to ram the truck and the silver vehicle to get free. Harter stated as the black car was getting free, he (Harter) heard two (2) gunshots come from the area. After the gunshots happened, everyone loaded up in vehicles and fled the scene. Harter completed a sworn written statement pertaining to the incident.

Deputies canvassed the parking lot of Fairchild Oaks Dental Care and discovered two (2) spent shell casings. In addition, an unfired pistol round was discovered in the parking lot. Also, there were pieces of vehicle parts found, consistent with a collision having occurred.

Given the totality of facts and circumstances, VSO Sergeant A. Bayne contacted the on-call detective sergeant who stated a detective would be responding and that a member of the crime scene unit (CSU) would also be aiding in the investigation.

Deputies attempted to view video footage from the 7-11; however, Aggar said he (Aggar) did not readily have access to view it. Deputies also checked with the local hospitals for anyone who had recently been brought in with a gunshot wound and were advised there were no

patients with that type of injury.

CSU K. Perciavalle responded to the scene and documented the area with photographs. Two (2) spent 9mm shell casings were collected from the entrance/exit area to the parking lot of Fairchild Oaks Dental Care and one (1) 9mm complete cartridge was collected from directly outside the main entrance to the 7-11.

Detective A. Patel responded to the scene and recontacted Aggar. Aggar stated prior to the event with the vehicles, two (2) unknown females had entered the 7-11 saying they had been in a fight with a heavier set female and were asking for some bandages. Aggar said other young people began showing up in the parking lot near the fuel pumps, and they seemed to all be familiar with each other. Then, Aggar observed a dark colored sedan enter the parking lot with a dark colored truck chasing it. The two vehicles drove through the parking lot and ended up in the parking lot of the dental office. Aggar said the dental office parking lot only has one way in and out, and by the time the dark sedan looped around, the only way out was now blocked by a light-colored sedan. Now, the dark colored sedan was boxed in by the light-colored sedan and the black truck. Aggar advised the crowd of folks in the 7-11 parking lot then began running towards the dark colored sedan and hitting it. Aggar said that in response, the dark colored sedan backed into the black truck and successfully drove over a curb to free itself. Aggar then heard two (2) gunshots and the crowd dispersed to vehicles and fled the area. Aggar stated while he heard the shooting, he did not see who fired the firearm.

Detective Patel recontacted Harter. Harter is an associate of Aggar and sometimes comes to the store to hang out. Harter provided a similar account of events as provided by Aggar.

During a walkthrough of both the Fairchild Oaks Dental Care parking lot and the 7-11, Detective Patel observed two (2) spent shell casings at the entrance/exit area to the dentist office parking lot and one unspent cartridge near the main entrance of the 7-11.

Later, on October 25th, VSO detectives were advised Annie Looper was contacting law enforcement saying she (Looper) was involved in the shooting that took place near the 7-11 in Ormond Beach. Detectives Patel and E. Mefford subsequently responded to Looper's home (5230 Christiency Avenue, Port Orange) to conduct an interview.

Looper said on the night of October 24th, 2025 and into the early hours of October 25th, 2025, she (Looper) and two of her friends, Zane Degraw and Anthony Whealan, drove (in Looper's dark green Chevrolet Cruz) to a bonfire gathering in Ormond Beach. At some point during the gathering, she (Looper) got into a physical fight with two (2) other unknown females. Looper said others from the party started to join in (against Looper) and then Degraw and Whealan started fighting some of the unknown males. Looper stated that she, Degraw, and Whealan were able to get back to her (Looper's) vehicle and that Degraw drove them away from the area. Looper advised a large pickup truck was following them closely, which resulted in Degraw pulling into the 7-11 parking lot. Looper said Degraw tried to drive away from the truck; however, was subsequently blocked into a parking lot by the truck and a light-colored sedan which she (Looper) thought might be a BMW. Looper said a large group of people began to surround her vehicle, hitting it and smashing the back windshield. Looper advised Degraw backed her vehicle into the truck and drove forward to get free from the situation. Looper said it was while Degraw was driving forward that she heard gunshots and they continued out of the area. Looper did not see the shooter and said no one in her vehicle was hurt during the incident. Looper said that after the event, on October 25th, 2025, Brandon Raymond came to her house to check on her and claimed one of his (Raymond's) friends might have shot at her (Looper's) vehicle. However, Raymond did not tell Looper the name. Looper stated that Raymond arrived at her house in a silver Kia Soul. Looper also disclosed that she (Looper) and Raymond engaged in consensual intercourse during this visit and Raymond left shortly after. Per Looper, Raymond has since blocked her from all communication outlets. Looper further explained that she and Raymond were never in a romantic relationship and have only associated with each other a few times at other social events. Looper swore to her statement and wanted to pursue criminal charges.

Detectives observed damage to Looper's vehicle and some potential projectile strikes. Looper provided the VSO with consent to have her vehicle towed to VSO evidence for processing.

The Volusia Crime Center (VC3) was utilized to aid in the investigation and were able to potentially identify the black truck involved in the incident. Investigation revealed that shortly after the shooting, a black Dodge Ram had been captured on law enforcement technology near the incident location. The truck was registered to Jorgen Radcliff, and Radcliff was contacted by detectives (via telephone) to determine what his (if any) involvement was with the event.

Radcliff admitted to being at a bonfire in Ormond Beach and that while there, there was a disturbance. Radcliff advised that someone (who Radcliff later learned was Degraw) had gotten into a vehicle (Looper's), and while leaving, smashed the car into a white BMW sedan. Radcliff subsequently got into his (Radcliff's) truck and began following Looper's vehicle, attempting to get the vehicle tag. Radcliff followed Looper's vehicle into the gas station parking lot and eventually to the parking lot of the dental office. Radcliff said the white BMW sedan stopped in front of Looper's vehicle and prevented the vehicle from leaving. Radcliff stated that Degraw then drove Looper's vehicle into his (Radcliff's) and then into the BMW. Radcliff told detectives at some point, a white male, wearing a black hoodie and a black ski mask shot several rounds into Looper's vehicle causing everyone to flee the scene.

Detectives then conducted a telephone interview with Raymond. Raymond said he was present for the incident; however, denied having anything to do with the shooting (saying he remained next to his vehicle which was parked next to the gas pump at the 7-11 when the shots were fired). Raymond also said he (Raymond) had no recordings of a fight which took place at the bonfire. Detectives found glaring inconsistencies with Raymond's statement as video from the 7-11 showed him (Raymond) nowhere near his (Raymond's) vehicle at the time of the shooting. Instead, the video shows Raymond in the direct vicinity of where the shooting occurred. Also, pertaining to video of a fight at the bonfire, it was Raymond who used his (Raymond's) Instagram account (bdotsvvs) to post a recording on social media of the disturbance.

On October 26th, 2025, Detectives Patel, Mefford, and Sgt. C. Weaver responded to Degraw's home and conducted an interview pertaining to the incident. Degraw said that he (Degraw), Looper, and Whealan were at the bonfire in Ormond Beach. Degraw stated a group of girls were attempting to fight Looper and he (Degraw) stepped in to prevent any disturbance. When Degraw did this, other unknown males at the party began fighting him (Degraw) thinking he had pushed the females. Degraw said that Whealan then came to his aid, and the fight became larger. Eventually, the parties were split up, and Looper, Whealan, and Degraw got into Looper's vehicle (with Degraw driving) and they left the scene. Degraw said a black truck began following them and he (Degraw) tried to lose it by driving through some parking lots. Degraw said he was subsequently boxed in by a BMW (to the front) and the truck (behind him) and a large group of people surrounded the car. Once the car was surrounded, the group began hitting and kicking the car while they (Degraw, Looper, and Whealan) were inside. Degraw said he drove around the BMW (contacting either the front or back passenger side of it) while passing it. After clearing the BMW, Degraw said someone fired a firearm at the vehicle, but he (Degraw) did not see who the shooter was. Degraw was sworn to his verbal testimony and declined to pursue criminal charges.

On October 27th, 2025, Detective Salinas was assigned this case for further investigation. Detective Salinas was advised by Detective Patel that Jorgen Radcliff had additional information he wanted to share and agreed to meet with detectives.

On October 27th, 2025, at approximately 2220 hours, Detectives Salinas and Mefford met with Radcliff at VSO's District 3 North office in Ormond Beach. Radcliff explained the same series of events as provided during the phone call with Detectives Patel and Mefford. Radcliff further expanded on the moment where the vehicles were by the Fairchild Oaks Dental Office. Once the BMW blocked the exit, the occupants from the BMW exited and began to yell at Degraw. After words were exchanged, the occupants returned to the BMW. After Degraw rammed into the BMW and Radcliff's truck, Degraw traveled towards the parking lot exit. Radcliff noticed a male, who he knew as "Bdot" (Brandon Raymond), standing near the exit. As Degraw drove past Raymond, Radcliff saw and heard Raymond fire two shots at the rear of Degraw's vehicle. Radcliff also saw the back windshield shatter at that moment. After hearing the shots, Radcliff was frightened and left the area. A few hours later, on October 23rd, 2025, Radcliff saw a Snapchat post from Raymond which showed Raymond holding a pistol in his hand. Radcliff was sworn to his verbal testimony and the audio recorded was uploaded to evidence.com.

On October 29th, 2025, at approximately 1420 hours, Deputy Vargas (who was not familiar with the details of the investigation) administered a six (6) person photo lineup (containing Raymond) to Radcliff. Radcliff positively identified Raymond as the person who shot at Looper's vehicle and signified the identification by circling and placing his initials by photo #3 (Raymond). The photo lineup was subsequently submitted into VSO evidence.

On October 29th, 2025, Detective Salinas met with CSU K. Perciavalle at the VSO evidence facility to see Looper's vehicle. Detective Salinas observed four (4) projectile strikes on Looper's vehicle. (Two strikes on the front end of the vehicle and two strikes on the rear end.) A projectile was located in the filler neck of the gas tank area and was removed by CSU for processing. (Please review CSU K. Perciavalle for further information.)

Detective Salinas asked Radcliff if there was anything significantly different that he can recall from anything he (Radcliff) stated to law enforcement which is different than what he stated today (October 29th, 2025) to which Radcliff responded with no. Radcliff was then asked, is it reasonable to say that what he recalled today is the best rendition of what occurred during the incident to which Radcliff stated, "it is". Detective Salinas then asked Radcliff if he recalled mentioning anything about somebody wearing a black ski mask. Radcliff responded that a bunch of people were wearing ski masks during the bonfire; however, during the shooting Radcliff recalled that Raymond possibly had a ski mask on but just around Raymond's neck. Radcliff recalled seeing Raymond's distinctive hair style to which he described as puffy curly dark brown hair with one red stripe.



Detective Salinas reviewed the video surveillance footage from Publix (3750 Roscommon Drive) captured on October 25th, 2025 at approximately 0107 hours. The rear camera dated showed a dark in color truck following a dark in color sedan behind Publix. The front camera showed the same vehicles traveling through the parking lot towards the Truist Bank then over to the 7-11 and Dental Office. Due to the trees and shrubs, the ramming of the vehicles and the shooting were unable to be seen. The video footage was uploaded to Evidence.com.

Detective Salinas then reviewed the camera footage from 7-11, captured on October 25th, 2025, which shows the same vehicles as the Publix's video but in a different angle. It should be noted that the video footage timestamp is one-hour behind from time of recording. This video footage captures Raymond standing in the 7-11 parking lot as Radcliff's and Looper's vehicles enter. Raymond is seen approaching the vehicles as they pass by and then run towards the dentist's office. As Raymond ran towards the dentist's office it appeared Raymond reached into the right side of his waistband. Due to lack of lighting coupled by the time the incident occurred, the ramming of the vehicles and the shooting were unable to be seen. Raymond is then seen running back to 7-11, entering the driver's seat of a silver Kia Soul, and left the area. An inquiry of law enforcement databases revealed that there is a silver Kia Soul bearing Florida registration QBRD69 registered at the same address as Raymond. Furthermore, a Kia Soul bearing the same registration (QBRD69) hit technology near the area of the incident at 01:09:37 hours on October 25th, 2025. Raymond is seen in the video footage arriving at 7-11 in a Kia Soul at 0107 hours and leaving at 0109 hours. Furthermore, Detective Salinas also observed Raymond having dark brown curly hair with a red stripe which is consistent with the description provided by Radcliff. The video footage was uploaded to Evidence.com.

Detective Salinas conducted a criminal history inquiry on Brandon Raymond which yielded negative results.

Based on the totality of the above-described circumstances, statements, physical evidence, and video evidence, Detective Salinas established probable cause to charge Brandon Raymond with one count of aggravated battery with a firearm and one count of firing a deadly missile into an occupied vehicle. Detective Salinas completed a charging affidavit and will be requesting an Arrest Warrant for Bradon Raymond.

Volusia Sheriff's Office Investigative Costs are above the standard minimum and are as follows \$500 dollars.
