Board Discussion: Commissioner Tucker questioned how the water was going to be piped. He further advised putting an irrigation system in the medians of US-1 would be a safety hazard. He said he

doesn't want to see this happen. City Engineer Tiblier responded the pipes will come from the reclaimed water retention pond in Grand Reserve. He also stated there is an implied agreement with FDOT that the City will maintain the plants in the median. Further, it helps us use the reclaimed water. City Manager Williams added it's too late now to not try to take care of these plants. FDOT gave us \$900K worth of plants and we're expected to maintain them. Also, based on the consent order, we need to use the reclaimed water. The safest way to water these plants is with an irrigation system. Otherwise employees would have to water them manually or use a water buffalo truck at less than 5 mph, which would not be safe either. Commissioner Robinson stated the plants make our city look beautiful and we should keep the plants alive. She worked on the BMS contract for years on US-1, and there was any safety problems. All cities have to work on their highways. Commissioner Baxley said he hears a lot of compliments about the plants. Irrigation will be the safest way to do this. Much safer than employees watering by hand. Vice Mayor Rogers said he remembers about a year ago in Volusia County when a mower was struck and killed by a vehicle. He agrees with Commissioner Tucker that our employees are more valuable than plants.

Pastor Willie Durden Sr. – We came tonight to address a problem. On our service nights; Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday, we have a lot of people parking on our private property and loud music playing, since those two bars have opened next door to us. We're concerned about drugs, alcohol, and fights, during our services. We need some help with this issue. We've asked them nicely to stop, but it's still happening. In response Mr. Williams said he, the police chief, and Mr. Cuthbertson will setup up a meeting with the church about this. It was also mentioned that the property owner (church) can have the vehicles towed.

Daisy Henry – Has a proposal for the two tigers (Carver school mascot) to be mounted at Carver Gym. (Photos attached to these minutes.) She has also gone to Flagler County to ask them permission to have them mounted. Mr. Williams responded that we would have to get with the county and determine a cost, and since this is not budgeted, it will have to come back to the

commission for approval.

David Barbee – I was a Sergeant with the City of Bunnell and was injured chasing a suspect in 2011. I'm now medically disabled because of numerous injuries. I put in a request for my medical id, firearm, and badge but was denied, with no reason given, by the city manager. This is a great injustice to me and my family. I worked for this city for 3 years, was decorated, promoted, and served as the training officer. I have paperwork showing I received my disability in November. Would like to know why I am being denied my retirement, but also why I couldn't be placed on the agenda to give you my paperwork. Responses: Mr. Vose – Not aware of his retirement. As a reminder, you amended your charter last year to not allow things to be added to the agenda at the meeting unless it was time critical, and this is not. Commissioner Tucker asked for this to be placed on the next agenda. Mr. Williams added he didn't know about the retirement either. It's not our custom to give these items out. These are possessions of the city. Every director is required to have those things returned to them. Commissioner Tucker then made a Point of Order stating we don't need to be discussing this until it's on the agenda. You have information that I don't have. This needs to be on the next agenda.

Maria Schalet – Flagler Wolfpack: On the 28th we had the spring football tournament at the Carver fields. It was a success. No complaints. We're happy how it turned out. On the 21st there's another round of games with teams coming in from the surrounding area. We did put in a request for the use of the fields. Please let me know if there are any issues. Commissioner Tucker, again, stated that considering this is not on the agenda, we can't really discuss it.

I think an extra set of eyes on anything would relieve staff and commission of some responsibility. There was a vacation on Court Street a few years ago that I don't understand. People use it every day. When the city repaved, they paved the vacated portion. The PZA should still be part of this process.

I. Reports:

• City Clerk: Nothing to report.

- City Attorney: I've been discussing rewriting portions of the code with Utility Director Bill Green, as I understand there has been some controversy over some of the water and sewer provisions for many years. I'll be looking to streamline and clarify a few issues and welcome any input the commission may have. Some of it is technical but has real life implications for multi-property owners.
 - City Manager: Thanked Ms. Gurnee and Ms. Bolser for filling in for him while he was away. Also, have spoken with the Palm Coast economic development personnel pertaining to the site you recently toured along US1. Hopefully, Mr. Vose and I will be coming to the commission shortly with a recommendation to approve a tax rebate program. It's similar to a tax abatement program but it's better because the taxes are paid up front and rebated at the end of the year. I've done this before to get businesses to come to your city. It works on a sliding scale where you rebate 80% the first year, 60% the second year, 40% the third, and so on. By the fifth year the business is paying 100% of the taxes to the city. I'm going to bounce this off the owner and see what he thinks about it.
 - Ms. Gurnee: Gave an after action report about the football tournament the Flagler Wolkpack held recently. Attendance was a good bit more than they anticipated. It was not 88 people per hour, but loomed toward 400 as originally

thought it would be. There were complaints. Some damage was done to shrubs in the parking lot. We billed them \$15 per shrub plus labor. PD feels they need two officers at next event. Parking was a problem. A complaint from Carver gym, as players used bathrooms and tracked mud through the basketball courts. They weren't prepared for the event. Carver asked for gym bathroom not to be used for future events. Garbage was put in Waste Pro bin (County) not the one the city provided. Also, we had reports that food vendors were on site. There is a Business Tax process for any temporary food vendors to ensure they are licensed. We'll be getting back with the Wolfpack soon so we can resolve these issues and hopefully prevent them from happening again.

Mayor and City Commissioners:

- Commissioner Robinson: Do we have the same reservation process for Carver fields as we do for the rest of the city parks? I don't understand why the Wolfpack needs to come to the commission to reserve the fields. Answer: They do not need to come to the commission. Staff can handle all reservation requests.
- Mayor Robinson: Our neighborhood is in mourning. Mrs. Silvia Wray, a neighbor we all loved passed away this past weekend.

To Flagler County Local Governments:

Each year we request, in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration requirements, authorization to fly over congested areas. As you are aware, the citizens you represent pay for mosquito control services via property taxes and a portion of the service includes aerial operations. To provide service in a timely fashion, without contacting each local government prior to each operation, we require a signed authorization that extends for one year. This matter has become a formality over the years.

For those unfamiliar with District operations, the authorizations permit the District to perform low-level flights (500 feet) over various entities for mosquito control. We <u>rarely</u> apply control materials over congested areas, but if the need arises, the authorization is necessary. The District is solely responsible for determining need, which would be based on an exceptional nuisance or an impending health threat.

The primary use for the aircraft is the control of developing mosquitoes away from congested areas, in and around wetlands.

The enclosed **Public Notice** will be published monthly beginning in April and ending in October, and serves to provide ongoing public awareness about aerial spray operations and further provides contact information. This should satisfy members of the various local governing boards desiring more notification for their constituents.

Please execute the accompanying authorization (Chairman, Mayor, etc.) and return to our office no later than April 15, 2015.

Stella,

Thank you for your patience with us! As discussed, the County applying for a CDBG project at the Carver facility in no way affects the eligibility of the City in applying for a CDBG project in the same FFY Cycle.

In my first conversation with you, I conveyed that we are of the opinion that a project in the City that predominately serves residents of the City should be a project that the City applies for. We base this opinion on our Administrative Rule that allows for beneficiaries outside the applying local government's jurisdiction, however, states that no more than 50% of the beneficiaries in the project may reside outside the applying local government's jurisdiction.

After discussion with our supervisor, we are still of the opinion that the City's residents would have more than 50% of the beneficiaries, however, we contend that it remains the County's responsibility to define the service area before we determine whether they have an eligible application.

In either case, whether the County applies for CDBG assistance for the Carver project or not, the City remains eligible to apply for CDBG assistance for their project of choice.

For the County to apply for CDBG assistance for the Carver project, they will need an interlocal agreement with the City. This interlocal agreement and the County's application would not affect the City's eligibility to apply for a CDBG grant, and therefore we see no eligibility reason for the City not to sign the interlocal.

the laws of the State of Florida, hereafter referred to	as "CITY", and FLAGLER
COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida	a, hereinafter referred to as
"COUNTY".	

WHEREAS, the COUNTY seeks to apply for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to develop a COUNTY-owned Community Center within the CITY limits that will provide services and programs for low-to-moderate income (LMI) citizens of the COUNTY and CITY; and

WHEREAS, the CITY has a mutual interest in success of the project and concurs with the COUNTY applying for the CDBG to carry out this activity; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CITY are in need of improving facilities, programs and services that will enhance the lives of LMI citizens of the County and CITY; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is necessary to fulfill the requirements of the COUNTY'S 2014/15 CDBG Application(s) and any other grants that the COUNTY might seek to fund the Carver Center Improvements within the CITY limits; and

WHEREAS, Sections 125.0101 and 180.02, Florida Statutes, respectively authorize the COUNTY and CITY to enter into such an inter-local government agreement for provision of the services contemplated by this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, no service area or other jurisdictional authority changes or related responsibilities have been approved by this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the CITY do hereby agree that the COUNTY has

certain resources that the CITY does not have in administering projects that are a priority for the community at large, and working together would increase the benefit and success of such needed neighborhood development projects so long as the CITY approves all actions requiring authorization on its behalf, and all grant program requirements are fulfilled.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Subject to the terms of this Agreement, the COUNTY and CITY agree that the COUNTY shall seek, administer, and inspect a CDBG grant necessary to complete the Carver Center project for the 2014-15 Fiscal Funding Years, and shall have responsibility for day-to-day administrative requirements of the grant, including but not limited to procurement, payment of invoices, and request for funds approval and submission.
- 2. The COUNTY and CITY affirm that all activities, projects areas and service areas are consistent with their comprehensive plans.
- The COUNTY shall be the applicant for this project, and the COUNTY'S
 policies and procedures shall govern in matters related to this grant.
- 4. The COUNTY, upon final grant closeout, shall be responsible for operation and maintenance of the facility.
- The COUNTY authorized staff shall review and provide written approval of the project plans and specifications prior to bidding.
- 6. The COUNTY agrees to sign applicable forms, including, but not limited to, the award agreement, environmental review, and closeout package and shall authorize by Board of County Commission Enabling Resolution officials or staff to sign administrative forms and similar documents required for the COUNTY to perform its duties required by the grant.

- 7. The CDBG grant funds and any other grant funds obtained and administered under this agreement shall be managed through reimbursement, as most grants require reimbursement of costs after expenditure, and the COUNTY will set up accounts and procedures to ensure timely request for funds from grant agencies.
- 8. This Agreement shall be construed solely to benefit the parties hereto and no third person, corporation, or other legal entity shall ever have the right to bring action to enforce the terms hereof.
- 9. This Agreement can be amended, only by agreement of both parties in writing, and no employees or agent has the authority to waive or otherwise amend the terms and conditions of this Agreement without specific written authorization of the parties hereto subject to CDBG conditions.
- 10. This Agreement shall become effective when executed both by the COUNTY and CITY and shall run until such time as the grant closeout is submitted and approved by the appropriate agency for all grants successfully obtained and managed for the 2014-15 FFYs. Upon the expiration of the term of this Agreement or upon this Agreement being declared void or unenforceable, any service being previously provided pursuant to the terms of this Agreement shall continue unless otherwise mutually agreed between the parties.
- 11. COUNTY and CITY mutually represent that they have the respective authority to enter into this Agreement.

OVERVIEW/SUMMARY: The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity has announced the application period for the Florida Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program, funds to benefit low and moderate income population while addressing urgent community development needs. The process for grant submission is lengthy and requires the appointment of a Citizen Advisory Task Force and several meetings which include two public hearings. The deadline for submission is the end of May 2015.

At the October 20, 2014 Regular Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, the Board approved a resolution to formally establish the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Citizen Advisory Task Force (CATF), and appointed seven unincorporated Flagler County residents to serve. At the December 1, 2014 Regular Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, the Board approved the utilization of the professional assistance of Guardian Community Resource Management, Inc. for grant writing and grant implementation.

Staff, working in conjunction with the CDBG CATF, have identified a potential project for the expansion of the Carver Center and would like to pursue a CDBG - Neighborhood Revitalization Application. The purpose of today's meeting is to conduct the first of two public hearings to review the categories of CDBG's and the proposed project for submission of a CDBG for Flagler County's Carver Center and to receive feedback from the community.

<u>FUNDING INFORMATION:</u> With the submission of this grant, staff is looking to secure the maximum amount of \$750,000.00 for construction, which would require local leverage of up to \$50,000 to secure the maximum points allotted. A total of \$90,000 was appropriated in the FY14/15 budget for the Carver Center Expansion, Capital Project #180557. If approved and awarded this project would be included in the FY15/16 Capital Project Budget.

Summary/Highlights:

This is a request to amend the Bunnell Code of Ordinances Section 54-1 Requests for vacation of streets, alleys or rights-of-way – Second Reading.

Background:

This Ordinance was approved on first reading at the March 9, 2015 Commission meeting.

Commissioners requested the Planning, Zoning and Appeals Board continue to review requests for the vacation of streets, alleys, and rights of way. This change has been made.

The Code of Ordinance provides regulations for the vacation of streets, alleys, and rights-of-way. These regulations are in need of revision.

The current regulations require that all of the owners of the land adjacent to the land sought to be vacated affirmatively consent to the vacating of a street, alley, or right-of-way. This type of requirement poses the risk of substantially complicating the vacating of a street, alley, or right-of-way, the vacating of which would be in the public interest.

The proposed ordinance changes the notification procedure to the owners of the land adjacent to the property to be vacated.

ORDINANCE 2015-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BUNNELL, FLORIDA AMENDING SECTION 54-1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING REQUESTS FOR VACATION OF STREETS, ALLEYS OR RIGHTS-OF-WAY; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE BY CERTIFIED MAIL TO ALL PERSONS WHOSE PROPERTY ABUTS THE PORTION OF A PUBLIC STREET, ALLEY OR RIGHT-OF-WAY PROPOSED TO BE VACATED; REMOVING A REQUIREMENT THAT ALL OWNERS OF LAND ADJACENT TO LAND SOUGHT TO BE VACATED MUST APPROVE THE VACATING IN WRITING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING PROVISIONS, SEVERABILITY AND APPLICABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Bunnell Code of Ordinances provides for procedures and requirements relating to requests for vacating streets, alleys or rights-of-way in Sec. 54-1, Bunnell Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, such regulations presently require that all of the owners of the land adjacent to the land sought to be vacated affirmatively consent to the vacating of a street, alley, or right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, such requirement poses the risk of substantially complicating the vacating of a street, alley, or right-of-way, the vacating of which would be in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Bunnell finds that an alternative requirement that the City provide notice by certified mail to all persons whose property abuts the portion of the public street, alley or right-of-way proposed to be vacated, postmarked no less than 10 days prior to the public hearing on the proposal, provides adequate and sufficient procedural safeguards regarding notice and opportunity to be heard with respect to the proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BUNNELL, FLAGLER COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1.

Sec. 54-1, Bunnell Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 54-1. - Requests for vacation of streets, alleys or rights-of-way.

- (a) All requests to vacate any public street, alley or right-of-way shall be in writing and notarized, shall be addressed to the city, shall include the legal description of all properties physically adjoining the land sought to be vacated and shall bear the printed name, address and notarized signature of the person making the request.
- (b) All requests shall include a cashier's check, certified check or money order, which will not be refundable, in the amount established by section 30-411.

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- (c) All requests shall include the name and address of all property owners who own land <u>abutting</u> the street, alley, or right-of-way adjacent to the land sought to be vacated.
- (d) Any approval by the city commission to vacate any street, alley or right-of-way shall be in ordinance form and in compliance with F.S. § 166.041.
- (e) The City shall provide notice by certified mail to all persons whose property abuts the portion of the public street, alley or right-of-way proposed to be vacated, postmarked no less than 10 days prior to the public hearing on the proposal. Such notice shall state the time and place at which the city commission will conduct a public hearing on the proposal, together with a copy of the proposed ordinance.
- (e) The petitioner shall present a petition to the city commission signed by all of the owners of the land adjacent to the land sought to be vacated, on forms provided by the city clerk.
- (f) Prior to public hearing the city clerk shall provide the city commission with proof that those owners of land adjacent to the land sought to be vacated were in fact notified. Such proof may be shown by the returned receipt of certified or registered mail, police service or by a signed acknowledgement of the person notified.
- (f)(g) The applicant must state to the city commission the reason for the request to vacate. The applicant must also submit a proposed site plan that shows the future use of the vacated street, alley or right-of-way.
- (g)(h) No street shall be vacated unless it is in the public interest or unless such street is no longer required for public use.
- (h)(i) There shall be no charge for the vacation of any street, alley or right-of-way except for the administrative costs as shown in subsection (b) of this section.
- (i)(j) Prior to the final reading of the ordinance, the planning and zoning board shall review all requests for vacating streets, alleys and public places and report its comments to the city commission.

Section 2. Implementing Administrative Actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Ordinance and to take any and all necessary administrative actions to include, but not be limited to, the adoption of administrative forms, policies, procedures, processes and rules. All development orders shall be issued in a manner consistent with controlling law and rendered in appealable form with the City Clerk. Denials of development approvals shall be issued in accordance with controlling law to include, but not be limited to, Section 166.033, *Florida Statutes*.

Section 3. Codification.

The provisions of this Ordinance, including its recitals, shall become and be made a part of the *Bunnell Code of Ordinance* and the Sections of this Ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention and the word "Ordinance", or similar words, may be changed to "Section," "Article", or other appropriate word; provided, however, that Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 shall not be codified. The Code codifier is granted liberal authority to codify the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, or application hereof, is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion or application shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.

RESOLUTION 2015-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BUNNELL, FLORIDA CREATING A PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE, PROVIDING FOR MEMBERSHIP, PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT BY THE CITY COMMISSION, PROVIDING FOR TERMS OF OFFICE, PROVIDING FOR PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR POWERS AND DUTIES; PROVIDING FOR STAFF ASSISTANCE TO THE COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it necessary to review existing rules and fees associated with the use of city parks; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to provide recreation services to the public, while creating a more cost effective use of taxpayer money; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need to gather information to properly address the needs of the entire community through a plan developed cooperatively involving all sports leagues and recreational activities in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to create an advisory committee to assist and provide recommendations, related to parks and recreation within the city, to the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONER OF THE CITY OF BUNNELL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: Created. A Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee is hereby created.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: Purpose. The purpose of the committee shall be to provide the Public Works and Parks/Recreation Director, City Manager and the City Commission with advice and recommendations on all policies, rules, regulations, and fees relating to the use of and reservations of public parks and recreation programs.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> Membership. The Parks and Recreation Committee shall consist of five regular members and one alternate member, who shall be appointed by a majority of the City Commission, and shall serve staggered three-year terms. Members may serve successive terms.

In order to establish staggered terms, the initial appointments to the Committee shall be for three members to serve three-year terms, and two members to serve two-year terms. The alternate member shall serve a three-year term. Members shall serve at the pleasure of the City Commission and shall serve without compensation.

Members shall include one City Commissioner, one Carver Sports Complex representative, one organized sports league representative, and two members at large. Members shall be selected

from residents, property owners, and active business owners located within the City. No fewer than three of the members shall be City residents.

The alternate member shall attend all committee meetings regardless of whether a quorum of regular members is seated. The alternate member may participate in committee deliberations and debate, but they may make motions and vote only in the absence or voting disqualification of a regular member or the vacancy in a regular member's seat.

<u>SECTION</u> 4: Officers. Officers of the Parks and Recreation Committee shall consist of a chairperson and vice chairperson. Officers of the committee shall be elected from among its membership. The chairperson shall preside at all meetings of the committee. The vice chairperson shall perform the duties of the chairperson in his/her absence.

SECTION 5: Vacancies. Appointments to fill any vacancy on the committee shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term of office, and shall not count as a term served by that appointee. If any member fails to attend three successive meetings, without cause and without prior approval of the chairperson, the committee shall declare the members' office vacant and the City Commission shall promptly fill such vacancy. In addition, the City Commission shall have the authority to remove any member with or without cause.

SECTION 6: Powers and Duties. The parks and recreation committee may act as a public forum for citizens to address concerns over city parks and recreation activities. The parks and recreation committee shall provide advisory oversight of public playgrounds, athletic fields, recreation centers and other facilities and activities on property owned or controlled by the city and designated as a public park, or on other properties with the consent of the owners and authorities thereof. The Committee shall review all reservation, rental and fee structures and resolutions for parks and make recommendations for changes. It shall have the responsibility to recommend any form of recreation activity that will employ the leisure time of the people in a constructive and wholesome manner. The parks and recreation committee shall advise and assist the city commission as needed or requested. Under certain circumstances and when deemed appropriate by the city manager and/or parks and recreation director, the parks and recreation committee may review requests for permits and make a recommendation relative to said requests for use and/or reservation of city parks or city park facilities.

SECTION 7: Meetings. Regular meetings of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee shall be held at least quarterly but no more than twice monthly at times and places designated by the committee, with at least 48 hours public notice. All meetings of the committee shall be open to the public. The committee shall have minutes of each meeting taken, which minutes shall be recorded with the City Clerk, and such records shall be open for public inspection. A majority of the committee shall constitute a quorum. At any meeting not having a quorum, any member present may call such meeting to order for the purpose of declaring such lack of quorum, and for declaring adjournment.

SECTION 8: Staff Assistance. The Parks and Recreation Department is hereby directed to assist the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee in its organization and in considering, formulating and making recommendations to the City Commission. The department shall provide for the publication and dissemination of meeting agendas, minutes, and public notices.

Additionally, the City Manager may make available to the Committee, staff of other departments to assist it in fulfilling its purposes.

SECTION 9: Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
